The County Mayor, Miami-Dade County, pursuant to Chapter 287.055, Florida Statutes, Sections 2-8.1 and 2-10.4 of the Miami-Dade County Code, Implementing Order 3-34, and Administrative Order 3-39, announces that the Miami-Dade Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) will require professional engineering services from five (5) qualified consultants for general planning consultant support.

The purpose of the GPC is to have a pool of architectural and engineering (A/E) consultants available to assist the MPO in providing transportation planning services. The first GPC contract was executed in July of 2000. This contract is for the sixth cycle of the program (GPC VI). Five consultants will be selected to provide professional planning services, as needed, to supplement the MPO's efforts in conducting the transportation planning process for the Miami Urbanized area and some regional efforts. The scope of work includes the provision of services in the areas of urban and regional areas transportation planning and mass and rapid transit planning and highway planning among other related areas. During the development of this contract, the consultants will perform the following tasks: coordination with other transportation partners, literature research, data collection, analysis and evaluations, field inspections, conceptual designs to visualize proposed recommendations, travel demand forecasting, public involvement, preparation of presentations to MPO standing committees, and final reports, among other related efforts to support the transportation planning process as required by federal requirements.

MPO intends to retain five (5) qualified consultants. The five (5) highest ranked firms will be forwarded to the MPO Governing Board for contract award. The term of each contract is for a three (3) year period. Maximum compensation for each contract is six hundred and sixty thousand dollars (\$660,000) inclusive of contingency. No minimum amount of work or compensation will be assured to the retained consultant.
