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SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED

The Contractor shall:

1. Provide Test and Evaluation for Hoist Model Nos. BL-20200 Series

The Contractor shall perform exterior examination of the unit to determine if unit has sustained any damage. If no damage exists, then the Contractor shall perform a functional Acceptance Test Procedure (ATP). The Contractor shall contact MDFR and provide a copy of the ATP results accompanied by recommended work to be performed. If damage exists and work needs to be performed, the Contractor shall contact MDFR for further direction before proceeding.

2. Provide Hoist Overhaul Services for Model Nos. BL-20200 Series

The Contractor shall perform the overhaul of equipment at Contractor's facilities. Hoists Model No. BL-20200 Series refers to the Contractor's ten (10) year overhaul hoists. In the event overhaul services will require additional expenses, the Contractor shall contact MDFR to obtain approval to proceed.

3. Provide Hoist Modification and Overhaul

The Contractor shall provide hoist modification from a five (5) year hoist to a ten (10) year hoist and overhaul for BL-20200-501 to BL-20200-517.

4. Provide Pendant CP-700 Test and Evaluation

The Contractor shall perform exterior examination of the unit to determine if unit has sustained any damage. If no damage exists, then the Contractor shall perform a functional ATP. The Contractor shall contact MDFR with results and obtain MDFR's approval to proceed. If damage exists, the Contractor shall contact MDFR for further direction before proceeding.

5. Controller EC-14000 3 Test and Evaluation

The Contractor shall perform exterior examination of the unit to determine if unit has sustained any damage. If no damage exists, then the Contractor shall perform a functional ATP. The Contractor shall contact MDFR with results and obtain MDFR's approval to proceed. If damage exists, the Contractor shall contact MDFR for further direction before proceeding.

6. Turnaround Time for Minor and Major Repairs

Turnaround time shall be performed between four (4) to six (6) weeks after MDFR's approval for hoist minor repairs and six (6) to eight (8) weeks after MDFR's approval for hoist major repairs, unless otherwise specified by MDFR. The Contractor shall deliver orders via FedEx Ground Service using MDFR's account. MDFR shall provide Contractor with MDFR's FedEx account number.

The Contractor shall provide expedited services at no additional cost for repairs, if needed, sooner than time specified above. The price for regular and expedited services shall be fixed.

All deliveries shall be made in accordance with good commercial practice and all required delivery timeframes shall be adhered to by the Contractor(s); except in

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such cases where the delivery will be delayed due to acts of God, natural disasters, strikes, or other causes beyond the control of the Contractor. In these cases, the Contractor shall notify the County of the delays in advance of the original delivery date so that a revised delivery schedule can be appropriately considered by the County.

7. Delivery Locations and Hours

The Contractor shall deliver items to the following County facility between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday:

8. Shipping and Handling

MDFR shall pay for shipping and handling charges for all deliveries. These charges shall be inclusive given the Contractor's responsibility to utilize MDFR's FedEx account as noted in Paragraphs 6 and 10.

9. Shipping Terms: F.O.B. Destination

The Contractor shall hold title to the goods until such time as they are delivered to, and accepted by, an authorized County representative.

10. Delivery of Emergency Orders

The Contractor shall make deliveries within four (4) business days (presumes product availability quoted upon receipt of emergency request for quotes) after the date of emergency order and shall deliver emergency orders via FedEx 2Day Service using MDFR's account. FedEx 2Day service must be pre-approved by MDFR prior to shipping emergency order. MDFR will provide Contractor with its FedEx account number.

11. Materials shall be New and Warranted Against Defects

The Contractor hereby acknowledges and agrees that all materials (except where recycled content is specifically requested or when material coatings are reconditioned) supplied by the Contractor shall be new, warranted for their merchantability, and fit for a particular purpose. In the event any of the materials supplied to the County by the Contractor are found to be defective or do not conform to specifications, the materials may be returned to the Contractor, at the Contractor's expense, and the contract shall be cancelled or the County may require the Contractor to replace the materials at the Contractor's expense.

12. Additional Items may be Added

The County reserves the right to add items on an as needed basis. The County reserves the right to negotiate the price of any new item that may be added to the Contract at a later date.
