

JUNETEENTH 2022



In 1863, during the American Civil War, President Abraham Lincoln issued the **Emancipation Proclamation**, which declared more than three million slaves living in the Confederate states free. It was not until Union soldiers arrived in Galveston, Texas, on June 19, 1865, when slaves learned that under the Emancipation Proclamation they had been freed. The name "Juneteenth" references the date of the holiday, combining the words "June" and "Nineteenth". June 19th is now "**Juneteenth National Independence Day**", a U.S. Federal holiday, commemorating the official end of slavery in the United States.
