The SEDC, in its role as an advisory committee to the Board of County Commissioners, recommends policies and measures to promote the economy of Miami-Dade County, with special attention to the needs of low-income

segments of the population. The SEDC aims to pursue a balanced perspective among economic development, social justice, and environmental sustainability. The SEDC, comprised of distinguished academics, non-profit leaders and other community volunteers, is a welcome addition to the Office of Community Advocacy and will be a great partner to our other advisory boards.

- Proof of income (W2, 1099-MISC, 1099R, SSA-1099, etc)
- Information for credits & deductions (mortgage, tuition, investments, interest, etc.)
- Small business documents and expenses (if applicable)
- Tax ID number or Social Security number of daycare provider and amount paid (if applicable)
- S Personal check with account/routing numbers for direct deposit of refund
- (\$) Copy of your previous tax return






