Hate Crimes Awareness Forum

The Miami-Dade County Asian American Advisory Board (AAAB) cordially invites you to a virtual Hate Crimes Awareness Forum via Zoom. With the assistance from the U. S. Department of Justice Community Relations Service (CRS), AAAB will be joined by representatives from Local, State and Federal law enforcement agencies to address the differences between a hate crime and a bias incident; what law enforcement resources are available to victims; and what steps someone can take if they believe they are the victim of a hate crime or incident.

At the Forum, representatives from the Black Affairs Advisory Board, Commission for Women, Community Relations Board, Hispanic Affairs Advisory Board, LGBTQ Advisory Board and Asian American Advisory Board – under the Office of Community Advocacy - will have the opportunity to address and share their perspectives and experiences on hate crimes and bias incidents and provide steps we can do to prevent such acts as a whole.






