
## Miami-Dade AAAB coordinates delivery of masks for the "Taiwan Can Help" Initiative



On Wednesday, September 30th, Miami-Dade County Commission Chairwoman Audrey M. Edmonson accepted a donation of 25,000 face masks from the Taiwanese Chamber of Commerce's Miami chapter on behalf of the Board of County Commissioners at the Joseph Caleb Center. The Miami-Dade County Public Housing Department received 15,000 masks for their senior residents, and the Lotus House and Curley's House Food Bank received 5,000 masks each. The donation was part of the "Taiwan Can Help" initiative by Taiwanese chambers of commerce to distribute more than 10 million masks to vulnerable populations. The Miami-Dade Asian-American Advisory Board under the Office of Community Advocacy coordinated the delivery of the donation together with the Miami-Dade International Trade Consortium, the Elders Affairs Advisory Board, the Commission for Women, the Domestic Violence Oversight Board, Hispanic Affairs Advisory Board and the Black Affairs Advisory Board.

## Hispanic Heritage Month 2020 Celebrations and Activities









The Miami-Dade County Hispanic Affairs Advisory Board (HAAB) celebrated Hispanic Heritage Month, during the months of September – October 2020, through presentations of various programs, activities, events and distribution efforts of food and personal protective equipment.

In the month of September the Board wrapped up their HAAB COVID-19 Task Force meetings, where they assembled over 25 recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners, focusing on the impacts of the Coronavirus to the most vulnerable populations in the community. On October 2 HAAB kicked off their cultural celebrations with the virtual Hispanic Art Expressions Exhibit- "Tones of the Quarantine". The week-long virtual exhibit, streamed live each day during the run of the program and featured over 60 works of art, by artists highlighting the diverse cultures that make up Miami-Dade County. On October 14, HAAB joined the Internal Services Department's Small Business Development Division co-hosting a virtual Vendor Outreach event, in an effort to promote business opportunities for those in the community interested in doing business with the County. October 13 - 20 HAAB cosponsored the 3rd Annual Hispanic Heritage Book fair together with the Mi Libro Hispano organization and with support of the Miami-Dade Public Library System. The book fair brings together more than a hundred writers each year, in addition to the participation of publishers, teachers, artists, and cultural and educational organizations. Each day of the book fair featured the launch of works in Spanish, English and bilingual editions, along with live readings, writing workshops, cultural performances and a chance to meet and greet the authors, writers and publishers. The virtual events brought in thousands of viewers and participants via the online and social media platforms and allowed the Board to reach a vast audience of our community during Hispanic Heritage Month! '


