Comparison of Miami Dade County Vendor vs. Non-County Vendor Furniture Pricing

This report is in response to Commissioner Heyman's request to perform a review of the County's costs of purchasing furniture from County vendors in comparison to the market price of furniture from Non-County vendors such as Amazon and Office Depot. The Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) contacted the following Non-County vendors to perform this review: Staples, Uline, Amazon, and Office Depot. We selected the following items of furniture for comparison: Clear View Storage Cabinet, Adjustable Standing Desk, Bolt Less Shelving Unit and Task Chair.

Our review revealed that the price from County's vendors was the most competitive in the case of the Clear View Storage Cabinet we compared. However, Uline price was more competitive than the price from County vendors in the case of the Adjustable Standing Desk and the Bolt Less Shelving Unit we compared. We found that the price from Office Depot was the most competitive in the case of the Task Chair we reviewed. Price from County vendors was the least competitive in the case of the Adjustable Standing Desk we compared. The table below shows a detailed comparison of prices between the County vendors and selected Non-County vendors.

Notes: The entities with the lowest price are highlighted. Although the specification of the above items were identical in terms of sizes, the OCA did not find identical specification in terms of the quality of material used for the products. The Non-County vendor prices were as of June 2017.

Per the advice the OCA received from the Internal Services Department (ISD), it is important to consider the following factors when evaluating the above results:

- A true apple to apple comparison between County vendors and Non-County vendors was not possible because the County buys commercial-grade furniture which is not generally sold by selected Non-County vendors
- The County has certain requirements such as Living Wage Ordinance, User Access Fee, Inspector General Fee, which are unique only to County vendors. These requirements may impact pricing by County Vendors

Supplemental information to Agenda Item No. 8F2 (*Recommendation for Approval to Establish a Prequalification Pool: Furniture Office and Non-Office*) provides additional information in response to the discussion at the May 2, 2017 Board meeting as follows:

• The recommended pool represents a 50 percent reduction in allocation as compared to the current pool.

- The requested allocation will cover purchases for resilient, commercial-grade furniture that will last for many years. Additionally, this grade of furniture offers the ability for offices within the County to re-purpose furniture as needs change.
- The County will monitor expenditures under this pool for office furniture by ensuring that purchases are limited to those that are operationally necessary for departments and will increase the useful life of the County's existing furniture through repurposing whenever possible.

- Except for Seaport and Aviation, Design and Construction Services Division of ISD purchases furniture for county departments, as well as for non-county agencies such as the State Attorney Office, Public Defender, and other state agencies and municipalities.
- Replacement cost <u>includes</u> replacement of county furniture that are more than 33 years old, located throughout county buildings (including SPCC, Hickman, and South Dade Government Center). ISD projected \$1.2 million for one floor replacement per year at SPCC.
