Board of County Commissioners Committee of the Whole - Budget September 7, 2016

Commissioner Sosa

- Sea level rise and climate need to limit studies and begin implementation; the Office of Resilience needs to be involved
- Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) concerned that all employees, including non-bargaining, will be treated equally and that all will be receiving COLA; Water & Sewer and Transit are still pending to execute bargaining agreements
- Ludlam Trail and Underline concerned regarding available funding (prior year funding is still available)

Commissioner Heyman

 Mosquito Control/Zika – the County should request reimbursement from the State and the Federal government (FEMA); reimbursements may then free up funds for additional priorities to be identified at the upcoming Budget hearings; further mid-year budget amendments will be reviewed for future adjustments

Commissioner Levine Cava

- Mosquito Control/Zika expects that both State and Federal funding is forthcoming
- Police need more than 40 new police officer positions
- Parks needs additional funding
- South Dade this area does not receive its fair share of funding; wants more funding for farm equipment; area needs additional economic development

Commissioner Jordan

- Water & Sewer concerned with the delay of the two non-consent decree projects (1) the North Miami-Dade Wastewater Transmission and Pump Station and (2) the South Miami Heights Water Treatment Plant and Wellfield and how this delay will affect the community in the future
- Independent Review Panel wanted to sponsor, unfortunately item was already sponsored; wants to co-sponsor and will request a sunshine meeting with Commissioner Suarez

Commissioner Souto

• Zika – this issue is extremely serious to our economy (including its impact to UMSA) and it is tied to our tourism; the County needs to engage in more planning
