Budget Development Process

- Budgets Submitted to OMB: February 9
- Virtual Budget Meetings: February 22 and 24
- Budget Development Activities: March June
- Final Preliminary Tax Roll: July 1
- Mayor's Proposed Budget Submission: No later than July 15
- Public Town Hall Meetings: August
- Public Budget Hearings: Sept 8 and Sept 20
- New Fiscal Year begins: October 1






