Ms. Sheree Benjamin, Contractor Enforcement Investigator, informed the Board that Mr. Jacques Jolicoeyr filed a complaint against Mr. Ylin Espinosa. She further informed the Board that Mr. Espinosa has a concrete finishing license and he installed drywall in the City of North Miami Beach without a permit. Ms. Julie Coffey then **moved** to send the above listed item to Formal Hearing. Mr. Iver Williams seconded the motion. The **motion carried unanimously**.

Ruben's Floor Solutions LLC. A2014003509

Ruben Perez, Qualifying Agent Carlos G. Harrington, Complainant

Mr. Francisco Arechaga, Contractor Enforcement Investigator, informed the Board that Staff received a complaint against Mr. Ruben Perez for a contract to install a floor in a condominium, where the Complainant gave him \$2,000.00 dollars as a deposit. After further investigation, the Condominium Association noticed that the Qualifying Agent only had Workers Compensation and he was denied access to complete the work. Mr. Perez informed the Complainant that he was willing to return \$600.00 dollars. However, he has not refunded the money to the Homeowner. Mr. Arechaga advised the Board that Staff would charge the Qualifying Agent with failure to Fulfil Contractual Obligations.

Mr. Daniel Vuelta, Contractor Enforcement Section Supervisor, informed the Board that he was hesitant on being able to sustain the charges against Mr. Perez. He further commented that the Qualifying Agent did try to complete the job, however the Condominium Association denied him access. Mr. Vuelta informed the Board that the Homeowner hired a different contractor to finish the job.

Upon further discussion, Mr. Iver Williams **moved** that no probable cause was found at this time. However, he motion to further address the matter thrugh the Informal Hearing process. Ms. Julie Coffey seconded the motion. The **motion carried unanimously**.

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Brito Awnings (Non-Agenda) A2015000735

Jose Brito, Qualifying Agent Miguel Valenzano, Complainant

Mr. Arechaga informed the Board that the Qualifying Agent was approved as a Contractor by the Board on December 17, 2014 and before obtaining his license he was contracted to install awnings in a shopping center. Mr. Brito obtained \$2,407.50 dollars as a deposit and purchased the material to replace the awning. However, he stated that the Homeowner gave him the wrong size. The Qualifying Agent removed the existing awnings.

Mr. Vuelta clarified to the Board that the Contractor was given the incorrect measurements and in the interim the Contractors obtained his license. Mr. Vuelta added that the Contract only mentions the materials, but no specification on the installation of the new awnings.

Upon further discussion, Julie Coffey **moved** that no probable cause was found at this time, however, to address the matter further thru the Informal Hearing process. Mr. Iver Williams seconded the motion. The **motion carried unanimously**.

At this time, Chairman Robert Stobs reconvened the prior discussions regarding applicant Carlos A. Ucles Zuniga.

Status of Payment Plan for Derogatory Credit

Mr. Michael Goolsby advised the Board that there is no provision in Chapter 10 for the Board to "terminate" the license. The suspension or revocation of the license must go through a disciplinary hearing process of the Board. He recommended that Staff should charge the individual with misrepresentation on his license application. The individual will be forced to appear before the Board and the Board could take any appropriate action with the license.

Assistant Attorney Michael Mastrucci notified the Board that the applicant was approved conditionally pending the plan. He advised the Board that the applicant's license should be denied because he was approved pending satisfaction of a payment plan. However, he agrees with Mr. Goolsby's recommendation to have a Formal Hearing and if the applicant has not complied with the payment plan, the Board has the jurisdiction to revoke the license. He further commented that this way the applicant can addressed any issues of due process.

Upon further discussion, Ms. Julie Coffey moved to **void** the previous motion to terminate Mr. Ucle's License. Mr. Iver Williams seconded the motion. The **motion carried unanimously**.

At this time, Ms. Julie Coffey then **moved** to fined probable cause and send the above listed item to Formal Hearing. Mr. Iver Williams seconded the motion. The **motion carried unanimously**.
