Mr. Richard Docobo, Qualifying Agent's Attorney, is requesting a reconsideration of penalty of the Formal Hearing held on February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

**<u>Result</u>**: Chairman Nestor Bustamante notified the Board Members that Mr. Cuadra, Qualifying Agent, was found guilty at the hearing held on February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2014, where the Board unanimously suspended the Qualifying Agent's License immediately for one (1) year, pay a fine of \$285.72 dollars per count in the total amount of \$10,000.00 dollars, and pay administrative costs incurred in the amount of \$992.00 dollars payable to Miami-Dade County. Mr. Bustamante informed the Members that the Qualifying Agent is requesting a reconsideration of the penalty.

Mr. Benjamin Simon, Assistant County Attorney, informed the Board that if they were to reconsider the penalty, Mr. Cuadra's Attorney would dismiss his current Circuit Court Appeal. He further advised the Board that if the County were to lose the appeal, the Qualifying Agent's Board Order would then be null and void. Mr. Simon indicated that the Board could impose a fine of \$4,000.00 dollars and a suspension of four (4) months on the Qualifying Agent's license, as this would maintain a penalty on the Qualifying Agent's record.

Chairman Nestor Bustamante commented that the Board could have implemented a fine up to \$5,000.00 per count. As such he advised that the penalty could be viewed as reasonable in light of the number of counts.

Mr. Richard Docobo indicated to the Board that he would drop the appeal, if the Board agreed to lower the penalty. He clarified that the issue of this case was whether Mr. Cuadra contracted for work of an Electrical Contractor, who actually did the electrical work, beyond the 50% of scope of the contract. Mr. Docobo informed the Board that there was no actual testimony presented that refuted the affidavits that he provided at the hearing. He clarified that he believed it was a reasonable compromise given the circumstances. Mr. Docobo notified the Board Members that the Circuit Court Appeal could result in the conclusion that the evidence submitted at the hearing was insufficient and a reversal of the Board's ruling.

Mr. Todd Stiff indicated that he was inclined to deny the request to reconsider the penalty. He advised that he would like to let the appeal go thru the process and allow the Court to determine if the Board's ruling was incorrect. Mr. Bustamante related that members have accepted Staff

recommendations before however it would not be the first time the Board has rejected the County's suggestion to reach an agreement. Mr. Simon clarified that the compromise proposed does not give up the finding of guilt and the Qualifying Agent would still be accessed with a fine and a suspension of his license. Board Member Irv Chazen stated that he believed the Board acted responsibly considering the evidence submitted by Staff and he doesn't see any reason to justify further leniency and would be comfortable with Court results.

Upon further discussion, Mr. Stiff moved to **deny** Mr. Cuadra's request to reconsider the penalty on the matter heard before the Board on February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Mr. Irv Chazen seconded the motion. The **motion carried unanimously**.

## **Board Discussion**

Electrical Inspection for Swimming Pools (Board Member Mr. Irv Chazen)

The Electrical Inspection Manual was provided to the Board Members to discuss the recent tragedies regarding swimming pools. Board Member Irv Chazen informed the Board that the Swimming Pool Association will be distributing information on how to prevent drowning and trapping in a pool. The Association will encourage the public to obtain the services of a qualify and certified electrician to inspect their pools. Mr. Chazen also indicated that a provision should be implemented that every pool should be recertified by a licensed electrical contractor or inspector. He emphasized that most pools built today don't have the issue of entrapment danger. Mr. Chazen indicated that he would like to see action on prevention of electrocution and drowning.

Mr. Michael Goolsby, Board and Code Administration Division Director, informed the Board that the issue is with the existing pools and property owner can be seduced by an unlicensed contractor. He advised the Board that his staff met with the media to educate the public on how to prevent this type of incident. Mr. Goolsby informed the Board that the Florida Building Code requires low voltage light on commercial pools but does not have same requirement for residential.

Mr. Oriol Haage, Electrical Training and Certification Officer, informed the Board that he serves on the Electrical TAC meet at the State for the Florida Building Code and has tried to enact the low voltage requirement.
