Product Control Advisory **Fire Barrier Language for** **Non-Structural Metal Roofing NOA Holders**

The Product Control Division would like to announce a policy change within our department that is scheduled to take effect on 10/01/10. This policy will affect the new, revision, or renewal submittals of Non-Structural Metal Roofing Systems.

The adjustment will be to the fire barrier language that is currently listed in the assembly section of the NOA. The new language will read as follows:

Fire Barrier: Any approved fire barrier having a current NOA. Refer to a current fire directory listing for fire ratings of this roofing system assembly as well as the location of the fire barrier within the assembly. See Limitation # 1.

The 'limitations' section in the NOAs typically includes language referring to fire classification. The following is an example of said language:

Limitation

- 1. Fire classification is not part of this acceptance; refer to a current Approved Roofing Materials Directory for fire ratings of this product.***

If the above limitation was inadvertently not included in the NOA, by no means should it allow the system to disregard this limitation. Section 1512.3.4 of the Florida Building Code (FBC) requires that the fire directory listing pages be submitted as an attachment to the Uniform Roofing Permit Application.
