System A:	1-3/4" Snaplock x 18" Wide Aluminum Panel
Deck Type:	Steel, Insulated
Deck Description:	22 gauge B Deck, Minimum 33ksi.
Slope Range:	2": 12" or greater
Maximum Uplift Pressure:	See Table A below

Deck Attachment:	Minimum 22 gauge steel deck shall be secured 6" o.c. to structural supports spaced a maximum of 5 ft. o.c. with one (1) #12 x 1-1/4" Tek 3 screws fastened at the bottom of each flute (6" o.c.). Deck sidelaps shall be fastened 6" o.c. with #12 x 1-1/4" Tek 3 screws.
Insulation:	Minimum 3/4" thick maximum 4" thick of an approved rigid board insulation with current NOA having a minimum 20psi compressive strength. Insulation boards shall be preliminarily fastened. See Coverboard for fasteners and density.
Coverboard:	A single layer of 1/2" DensDeck Roof Board was applied over the insulation fastened with approved #15 pancake head screws long enough to penetrate the steel deck through 3" diameter insulation plates. Use 16 fasteners and plates for every 4' x 4' board. Fastening density shall be in compliance with applicable Building Code and Roofing Application Standard RAS 117.
Underlayment:	Englert Metalman HT self-adhering underlayment or any Miami-Dade County Product Control Approved underlayment having a current NOA.
Fire Barrier:	Any approved fire barrier having a current NOA. Refer to a current fire directory listing for fire ratings of this roofing system assembly as well as the location of the fire barrier within the assembly. See Limitation # 1.
Valleys:	Valley construction shall be in compliance with Roofing Application Standard RAS 133 and with the current published installation instructions and details in Metal Alliance Inc's Roofing Installation Manual.
Metal Panels and Accessories:	Install the "1-3/4" Snaplock Aluminum Panels" including flashing penetrations, valleys, end laps and accessories in compliance Metal Alliance Inc's current, published installation instructions and in compliance with the minimum requirements detailed in Roofing Application Standard RAS 133.

1-3/4" Snaplock Aluminum Panels shall be secured with clips at a spacing listed below in **Table A**. Clips are to be fastened with a minimum of two #15 pan head self-tapping screws of sufficient length to penetrate through the deck at a minimum of 1/2".

Snap fit the female end of the adjacent panel over the clip/panel male assembly.

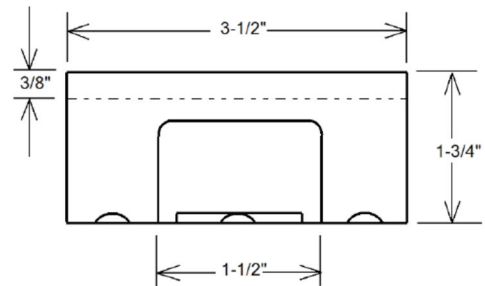
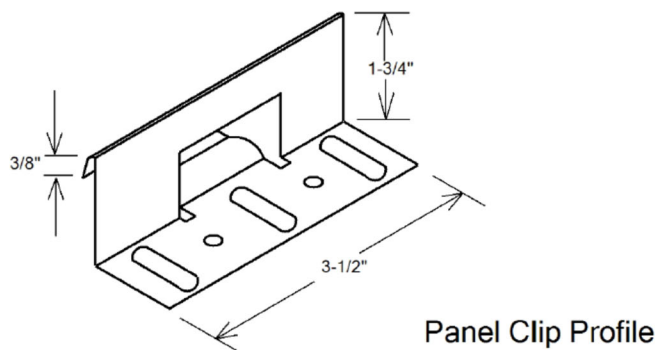
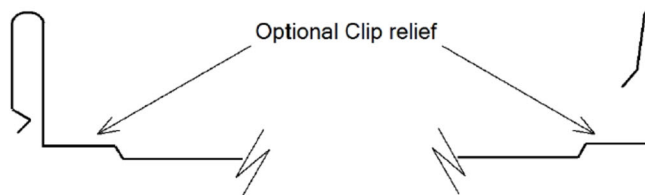
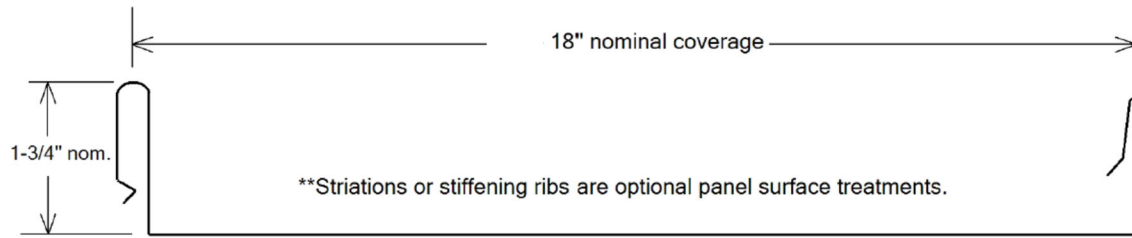
- 1 Fire classification is not part of this acceptance; refer to a current Approved Roofing Materials Directory for fire ratings of this product.
- 2 The maximum designed pressure listed herein shall be applicable to all roof pressure zones (i.e. field, perimeters, and corners). Neither rational analysis, nor extrapolation shall be permitted for enhanced fastening at enhanced pressure zones (i.e. perimeters, extended corners and corners).
2. Panels may be rolls formed in continuous lengths from eave to ridge. Maximum lengths shall be as described in Roofing Application Standard RAS 133
3. All panels shall be permanently labeled with the manufacturer's name and/or logo, and the following statement: "Miami-Dade County Product Control Approved" **or** with the Miami-Dade County Product Control Seal as seen below. All clips shall be permanently labeled with the manufacturer's name and/or logo, and/or model.
