System A-1:	Series 1300 Metal Roof Panels 20" wide
Deck Type:	Steel, Insulated or non-insulated
Deck Description:	Metal roof deck 22 MSG grade A. coated steel. Panel continuous over two or more spans without endlaps.
Slope Range:	1": 12"
Maximum Uplift Pressure:	See Table A below

Deck Attachment:	Minimum 22 gage steel deck shall be secured 12" o.c. to structural supports spaced a maximum of 5 ft o.c. with one (1) #12-14 x 1" Hex Washer Head screws. Deck sidelaps shall be fastened 12" o.c. with @12-14 x 1" Hex Head self-drilling screws.
Insulation:	(Requires a bearing plate for clip attachment) Maximum ¾" - 4" thick of an approved rigid board insulation with current NOA having a minimum 20psi compressive strength fastened with approved fasteners and plates. Fastening density shall be in compliance with applicable Building Code and Roofing Application Standard RAS 117.
Underlayment:	Minimum underlayment shall be an ASTM D 226 Type II installed with a minimum 4" side-lap and 6" end-laps. Underlayment shall be fastened with approved corrosion resistant fasteners and plates. Spaced 12" o.c. on the laps and two rows spaced 24" o.c. in the field of roll. Or Englert HT Underlayment or any Miami-Dade County Product Control Approved self-adhered underlayment.
Fire Barrier Board:	Any approved fire barrier having a current NOA. Refer to a current fire directory listing for fire ratings of this roofing system assembly as well as the location of the fire barrier within the assembly. See Limitation # 1.
Valleys:	Valley construction shall be in compliance with Roofing Application Standard RAS 133 and with Englert's current published installation instructions.



Metal Panels and Accessories:

Install the "Series 1300 Panel" and accessories in compliance with the current published installation instructions and details in Englert's Installation Manual. Flashings, penetrations, valley construction and other details shall be constructed in compliance with Roofing Application Standard RAS 133.

1. Each roof panel is attached to the steel deck along its male rib using the approved two-piece floating clips located 3" from each panel end and at a spacing as listed in **Table A** below. Each clip is attached to substrate with two (2) corrosion resistant 1/4" self drilling pan head screws of sufficient length to penetrate through the deck a minimum of 1/2". Note that each clip shall be placed on top of the bearing plate.
2. Attach adjacent panel by placing the female rib over the male rib and clip. Standing seams shall be mechanically seamed to a full 180 degree seam, (double lock).

For slopes of 1:12 and less than 2:12, apply two 3/16" beads of a Miami Dade Approved Sealant on the male leg before installing the female rib.

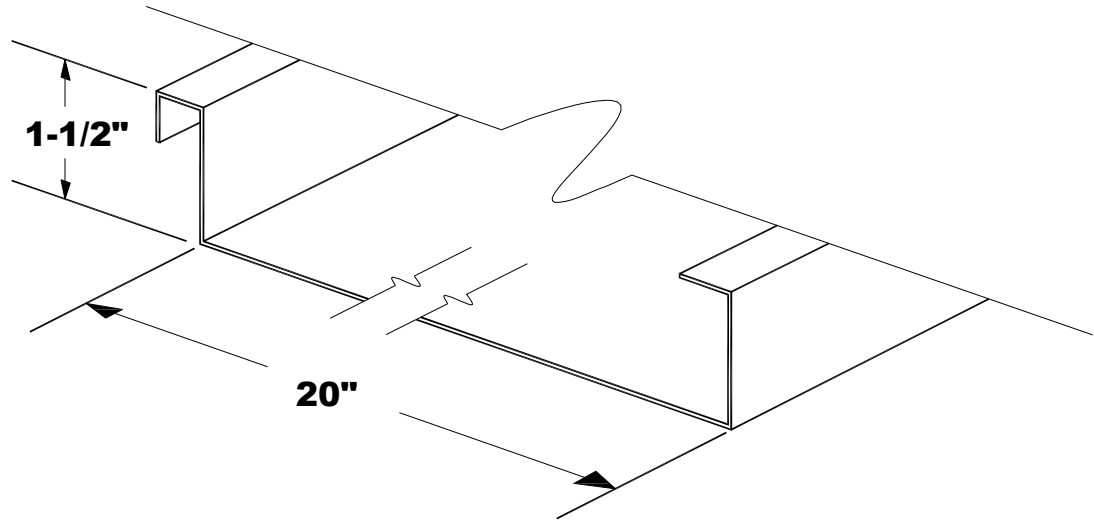
1. Fire classification is not part of this acceptance; refer to a current Approved Roofing Materials Directory for fire ratings of this product.
2. The maximum designed pressure listed herein shall be applicable to all roof pressure zones (i.e., field, perimeters, and corners). Neither rational analysis, nor extrapolation shall be permitted for enhanced fastening at enhanced pressure zones (i.e., perimeters, extended corners and corners).
3. Panels may be rolls formed in continuous lengths from eave to ridge. Maximum lengths shall be as described in Roofing Application Standard RAS 133
4. All panels shall be permanently labeled with the manufacturer's name and/or logo, and the following statement: "Miami-Dade County Product Control Approved" **or** with the Miami-Dade County Product Control Seal as seen below. All clips shall be permanently labeled with the manufacturer's name and/or logo, and/or model.



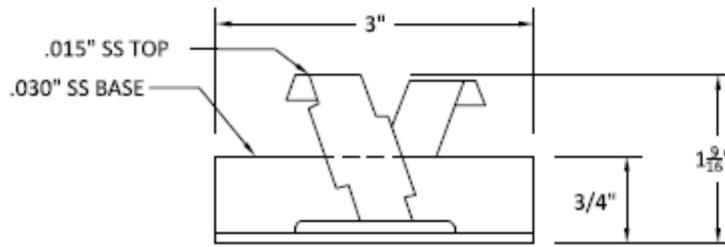
5. All products listed herein shall have a quality assurance audit in accordance with the Florida Building Code and Rule **61G20-3** of the Florida Administrative Code.

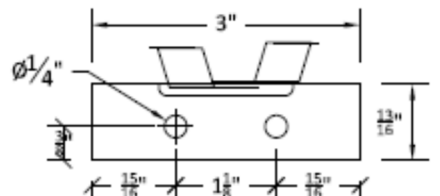


SERIES 1300 METAL PANEL



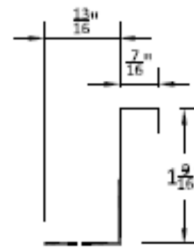
FLOATING CLIP

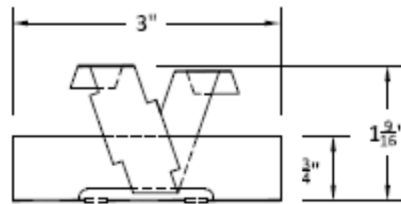
FLOATING BASE TOP VIEW

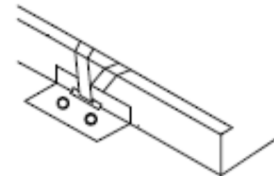
FLOATING BASE SIDE VIEW

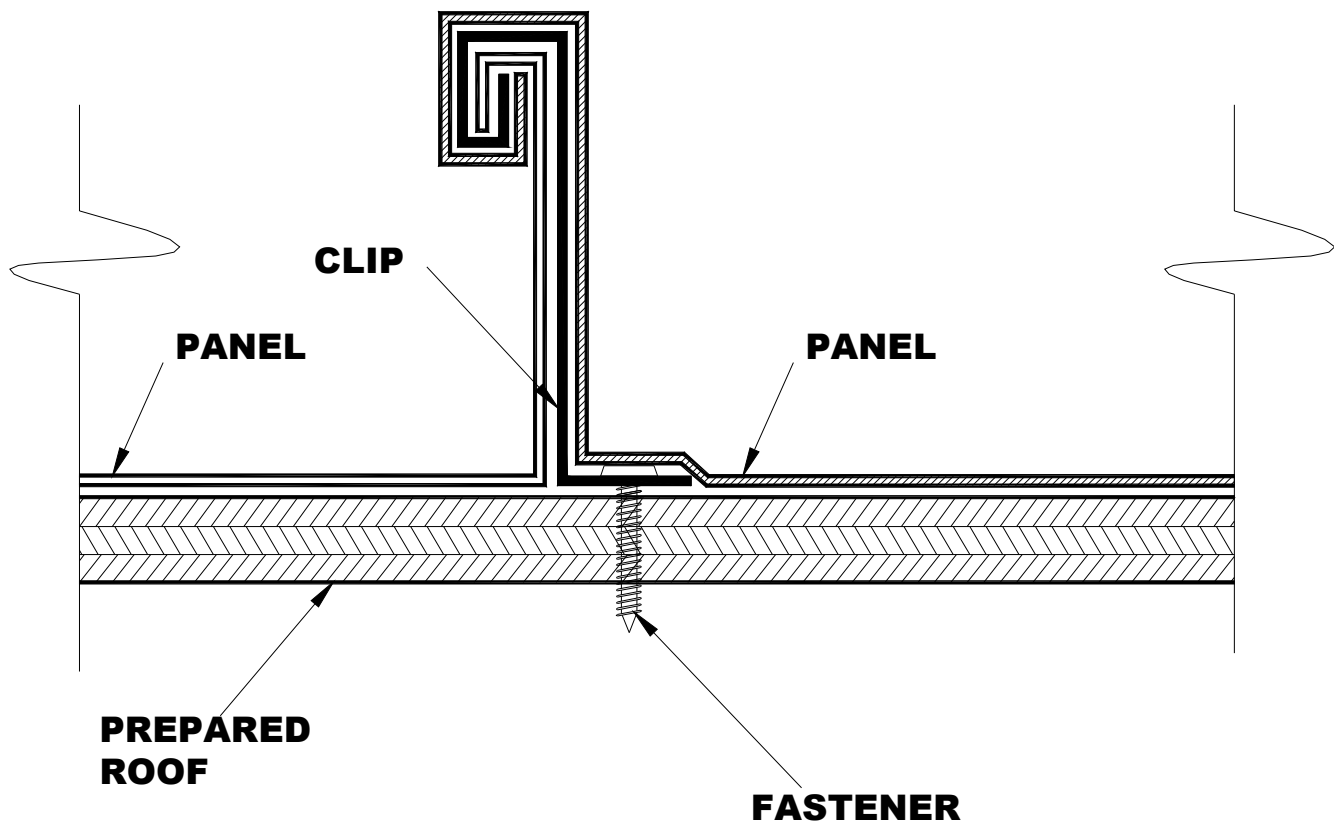


FLOATING BASE FRONT VIEW
