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Summary of the 2010 American Community Survey, 1-Year Estimates

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA

SEPTEMBER 22, 2011



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Highlights

Economic Characteristics

- **Income:** Median household income, the income of the ‘typical’ household in Miami-Dade County, declined in current dollars by 3.2% from \$41,533 in 2009 to \$40,219 in 2010. Adjusting for inflation the decline becomes a 4.7% one-year decrease. Median family income decreased by 3.3% from 2009 to 2010 to \$46,126. In inflation adjusted terms this is a 4.8% decline. Income per capita also decreased, by 2.5% in current dollars, to \$20,970 in 2010, and 4% after adjusting for inflation.
- **Poverty:** The poverty rate for all families in Miami-Dade surged to 16.4% in 2010, up 2.3 percentage points from 2009. The poverty rate for families with children under the age of 18 increased to 21.7%, 2.1 percentage point higher than in 2009. For married-couple families the poverty rate in 2010 hit 10.9%, and 13.2% when children under 18 were present. Families with a female householder and no husband present had a poverty rate of 28.1% in 2010 and 36.4% when children under 18 years of age were present.
- **Health Insurance:** Only 68% of the Miami-Dade population had health insurance in 2010, either private or public, down 2.3 percentage points from 2009. The number of children under the age of 18 without health insurance, however, declined by nearly 13,000 from 2009 to 2010 (-1.4%) to a rate of 16.7% of all children under 18. Among the working age population 61% of all employed residents had health insurance, just 32% of the unemployed had insurance, and for those not in the labor force, 55% had some form of health insurance.

Social Characteristics

- **Households:** The number of households in Miami-Dade in 2010 declined slightly to 809,689 (-0.4%) from a year earlier, and the number of family households fell by 1% to 556,730. The number of non-family households, however, increased by 0.9% between 2009 and 2010. Households comprised of unrelated persons continued to rise as economic conditions deteriorated, reaching nearly 46,000 in 2010, up 7.5% from 2009 and nearly 30% from 2007.
- **Education:** The percentage of the population 25 years old or older that earned a high school diploma or higher has remained steady at around 77%. The number of residents over 24 years old with a bachelor’s degree or higher remains at 25% in 2010, nearly the same percentage as in 2009 but down 2.6 percentage points from its previous peak in 2008.
- **Place of Birth:** The foreign-born population, long in the 50% range, jumped to 52% of the total population in 2010. This group grew by 4.8% over 2009 and by nearly 11% since 2004. Ninety-four percent (94%) of the foreign-born population came from Latin America. Language isolation appears to be high for some resident. Nearly half of residents above the age of 5 years who speak a language other than English at home, speak English less than “very well.”



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Housing

- **Vacancy Rates:** The overall housing vacancy rate in Miami-Dade stood at 18.2% in 2010 up from 17.1% last year and 11.9% in 2004. In 2010 nearly 180,000 housing units were vacant compared to fewer than 110,000 in 2004. The vacancy rate of owner occupied units more than doubled over the period from 2.2% in 2004 to 4.6% last year. The rate for rental units grew from 8.4% to 9.7% over the same time period. Most of the vacant units fall into the “other vacant” category not explicitly reported in the ACS. These are vacant units that are not seasonal homes and are not being offered for rent or sale and should include homes that are abandoned or in some stage of the foreclosure process.
- **Value and Cost Burden:** The median value of owner occupied housing units declined by more than 13% from \$238,500 in 2009 to \$207,100 in 2010. Since 2007 the median has dropped nearly 35%. The median monthly owner costs of housing units with a mortgage in 2010 dropped 4.4% from 2009 to \$1,779 per month, and dropped 7% from 2008. Of these units, 51% of owners pay more than 35% of their monthly household income in owner costs. Among renter households, 57% pay more than 35% of their monthly household income on their rent.

Demographics

- **Age Distribution:** The population of Miami-Dade County was nearly flat from 2009 to 2010, growing by just 0.2% to 2,505,379 according to the ACS. The population under 18 years of age in 2010 was estimated at 546,160, representing a decline of over 5% between 2009 and 2010, and by nearly 7% between 2004–2010. At the other end of the age scale, the population 65 years of age and above (354,798) declined 1.6% between 2009 and 2010, although it stood 14.5% above its level in 2004. The working age population, 18 to 64 years old, (1,604,421) in 2010 increased 2.6% over 2009 and by 12.9% over 2004.
- **Hispanics/Race:** The Hispanic share of the population continues to grow. In 2010 Hispanics in Miami-Dade totaled 1,633,415, more than 65% of the total. In 2009 Hispanics accounted for 62.5% of the County total, and the share was 60.6% in 2004. Nearly 54% of the 2010 Hispanic population identify themselves as Cuban. White-Not Hispanic residents totaled 381,573 in 2010, 15% of the total population. This group accounted for nearly 19% of the population in 2004. Black-Not Hispanic totaled 431,649 in 2010, 17.2% of the total, compared to 18.6% in 2004.
