



Variations in Unemployment Rates within Miami-Dade County

*Geographic Analysis of Unemployment Data from the 2005–2009,
American Community Survey, U.S. Census Bureau*

The Geography of Employment and Unemployment In Miami-Dade County: Brief Summary


The U.S. Census Bureau in early 2011 released new estimates of social, economic, demographic and housing characteristics for small geographic areas within U.S. counties. This new data is based on surveys of households conducted between 2005 and 2009. The survey responses over the 5-year period were pooled together to provide estimates of important socio-economic and housing indicators for relatively small areas, with a reasonable range of statistical accuracy. The estimates appear in the *American Community Survey: 2005-2009* (ACS 05-09) and should be considered as representative of conditions during that five-year period. This period contained two years of robust economic growth (2005-2006), followed by a year of deteriorating economic conditions (2007) and ultimately a steep recession (2008 through mid-2009). The unemployment rates within the County's 346 populated census tracts shown in the following map and the unemployment and labor force data provided in the following tables therefore represent the *average* values of the respective economic indicators over this 5-year period. Current unemployment rates in the County as a whole are higher than in 2005-2009, but the current geographic variation of unemployment rates and related economic indicators are not likely to be much different from the pattern revealed in the ACS 05-09. The latest ACS provides a strong base for examining the relative differences in unemployment rates among the County's various neighborhoods.

Every commission district had neighborhoods with higher-than-average unemployment rates, but rates are typically highest within neighborhoods in the northeast and southern areas of the County, excluding neighborhoods along the coast. Nearly 90,000 persons of working age (16 to 66 years old), lived in neighborhoods with unemployment rates that were at least double the County's average unemployment rate of 7.6% in 2005-2009. Twenty-four (24) census tracts had unemployment rates exceeding 15.2% in 2005-09. Twenty-one (21) of those high unemployment rate census tracts were located within Districts 1, 2, or 3. One-half of the high unemployment census tracts, with a combined working-age population of 32,200, had unemployment rates that were at least 2.5 times the countywide unemployment rate (19% or higher).

Eight (8) census tracts, where unemployment rates met or exceeded twice the County rate, were located entirely within District 2, plus an additional 2 were partially within that district. The combined working age population in these areas was 33,100 and unemployment rate was estimated at 19.2%. Not only was the unemployment rate for these tracts substantially higher than the county average, but the proportion of the working-age population participating in the labor force was also 18 percent lower than average. An unusually low *labor force participation rate* among the working-age population in areas where unemployment rates are chronically high suggests that a significant number of potential workers may have stopped looking for employment ("discouraged workers"). The official unemployment rates do not consider such workers. The unemployment rate in these 10 census tracts in District 2 could be as high as 31%, if the low labor force participation rate in fact reflects "discouraged workers" or hidden unemployment.


District 3 had seven (7) high unemployment census tracts, with a combined unemployment rate of 18%. The working age populations of those census tracts were estimated at 22,600, and the proportion of the working-age population participating in

the labor force was 21 percent below the county average (74%). The unemployment rate adjusted for potential hidden unemployment could be as high as 33%.

Six (6) census tracts in District 1 (with a combined working age population of nearly 34,000) had unemployment rates that met or exceeded twice the County unemployment rate. The combined unemployment rate for those six census tracts was 18%. Similar to Districts 2 and 3, the proportion of the working age population participating in the labor force was lower than in the county as a whole (61% versus 74%). The unemployment rate adjusting for hidden unemployment could have been as high as 22%.


Three (3) census tracts within District 9 also had comparatively high unemployment rates. The three tracts had a combined unemployment rate of 19%. Unlike the high unemployment tracts in Districts 1, 2, and 3, the share of working-age population participating in the labor force was approximately equal to the countywide participation rate.

One census tract (36.01) near the downtown core with boundaries within Districts 5 and 3 had an official unemployment rate of 17.5%. The Census Bureau indicates, however, that approximately 50% of the working-age population in that census tract formally participates in the labor force and, therefore, an unemployment rate that incorporates potentially hidden unemployment could be as high as 44%. This census tract includes neighborhoods east of the Miami River and west of the Florida East Coast Railway between NW 5th Street and SW 6th Street. (A portion of northern boundary of that census tract extends to NW 11th street at its northwest boundary.)

The following map provides a visual representation of areas with high or low unemployment rates relative to the countywide average. The tables provide the key employment, unemployment and labor force indicators for each commission district and for each census tract within each district.
