Soil and groundwater laboratory analysis for chemicals in accordance with EPA or appropriate methodologies and applicable certifications.

- **Monitoring Well/Soil Boring Installation**

Advancement of soil borings and installation of monitoring wells for determination of concentration of chemicals in accordance with applicable licensing requirements for drillers.

- **Contaminated Soil & Water Disposal**

Disposal of contaminated soil and groundwater generated as a result of monitoring well/soil boring installation and environmental restoration, at appropriate and permitted disposal facilities.

- **Environmental Remedial Construction**

Storage system removal/replacement, source removal, remedial system construction.

- **Materials/Equipment/Permit & Fees**

Cones, barriers, other Maintenance of Traffic materials, clean backfill material

OVA & other meters, data loggers, metal detectors, safety equipment, backhoe

Monitoring well installation permit fees, remedial construction permit fees, technical review fees
