SCOPE OF WORK/DESCRIPTION: furnishing all materials, labor and equipment necessary to rehabilitate interior of Water Storage Tank; the work shall consist of, but not limited to, high pressure washing all interior tank surfaces from top to bottom; perform rebar and concrete repairs on clean concrete surfaces; application of WASD furnished primer; application of WASD furnished hybrid epoxy coating; provide any scaffolding; transportation and handling costs; disposal of any debris; and all other appurtenances and miscellaneous items for a complete restoration of the interior surfaces of the tank. All steel surfaces shall be waterblasted, cleaned, prepared, primed and coated. New replaced steel shall be sandblasted to create surface profile to accept primer and coatings. All interior concrete surfaces of the tank shall be waterblasted, cleaned, prepared, primed and coated. Site restoration to existing or better conditions.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: **Prime Contractor** must possess certification in the application of the coating material Epoxy coating system Uroflex 61 as manufactured by Epoxytech and furnished by the Department to ensure proper application and a timely repair.
