


Quarterly Trade Summary: 2nd Quarter 2010 September, 2010


Trade by Region

- Miami-Dade County imports grew from the 2nd Quarter of 2009 by 44.6% at the Airport, 15.6% at the Port and 31.3% overall in the County.
- The largest regional source of imports was Central America (23%) which grew by 75% year over year.
- South America (22.5%) was close behind followed by Europe and Asia. China was the largest individual trading partner, accounting for nearly \$900 million of imports.
- Exports grew from the second quarter of 2009 by 22.4% for the County, 24.4% at the Airport and 16.2% at the Sea Port.
- Exports were dominated by South American trade, accounting for nearly 54% of the total with a year over year growth rate of 17%.
- Europe (+55.7%), Central America (+28.9%) and Southeast Asia (+26%) all grew much more rapidly but started from a much smaller base.
- Brazil was, by far, the largest export destination accounting for over \$2.1 Billion in exports from Miami-Dade. Number two was Switzerland, receiving just half as much, \$1 billion.

2010 Q2 Imports




2010 Q2 Exports




Trade by Commodity

- The largest category of commodities imported through Miami-Dade was Machinery which grew by nearly 49% over the 2nd quarter of 2009, and accounted for 40% of the growth of all imports.
- Stone and Glass imports were the 3rd largest category of imports in the 2nd quarter of 2010 by accounted for 22% of all import growth right behind machinery.
- Machinery accounted for 44% of all exports and grew over 23% from the 2nd quarter of 2009.
- The second largest category of exports was Stone and Glass products which accounted for only 12% of total exports but grew by nearly 84% year over year.

Miami-Dade County Imports




Miami-Dade County Exports








