



## Developing a successful grant takes work Focus

- Better to pursue a <u>single grant opportunity award</u> than utilize a shotgun approach.
- Writing multiple grants applications in hope that one will stick, may be time consuming and non-productive.






Recommended: FOCUS on 1 Grant

#### **Types of Federal Grants:**

<u>Non-Competitive</u> (Formula Grants, Entitlements/Block Grants generally awarded through states, counties or cities)

<u>Competitive</u> (FTA awards grants to applicants in response to its request for proposals or notice of funding availability/opportunity-NOFA/NOFO)










Write Proof read and peer review




Increase Local Match Maximize your local contribution



Don't inflate.

Build a relationship with the funding source Ask for technical assistance if needed during the application process





## Steps to Success







#### Sell It

- Prepare one-pager and/or presentation
- Secure letters of support from stakeholders
- Engage lobbyist

#### Achieve

If Awarded, **CELEBRATE** and then get to **WORK** 

- If unsuccessful, don't take it personally. You gave it your best shot.
- Contact agency and request a debriefing.
- Try, try again.



#### Do your Homework

- Track grant opportunities
- Find a good fit project
