




What is your position with the municipality?






What is the % of your municipality's surtax dollars currently dedicated to transit?






What transit/mobility service(s) does your municipality operate w surtax funds?






What does your municipal transit system connect to?






What, if any, mobile apps do you offer for your transit service?






How do you promote your PTP funded projects?








How should County (non-municipal) surtax/PTP dollars be prioritized?









Helping with grant solicitations, promoting coordination among municipalities to obtain information on cost for transit service received.






How can the CITT better serve your municipality?
