


Service Development Program

Program Requirements

- FDOT Procedure Topic Number <u>725-030-005</u>
- > Discretionary grant program
- New/Improved methods for Operation and Maintenance
- New/Improved Marketing efforts (2 years funding max)
- New Service and Existing Service Efficiencies
- Maximum funding duration three (3) years
- > 50/50 participation between FDOT and the Agency
- Successful projects are expected to be continued by the public transit provider without additional Service Development Program funds
- > Must comply with System Safety Oversite Rule Chapter 14-90, Florida Administrative Code

Transit Corridor Program

Program Requirements

- ➢ FDOT Procedure Topic Number <u>725-030-003</u>
- Discretionary grant program
- Provides funding to transit agencies and municipalities for projects that alleviate congestion or other mobility issues within a specific corridor
- The District may program up to one hundred percent (100%) of the cost for transit corridor projects, as provided by statute
- Examples of eligible items: Express bus service, local circulator, purchase additional vehicles
- Must comply with System Safety Oversite Rule Chapter 14-90, Florida Administrative Code

State Park-and-Ride Lot Program

Program Requirements

- FDOT Procedure Topic Number <u>725-030-002</u>
- Discretionary grant program
- The purchase and/or leasing of private land for the construction of park and ride lots.
- Aimed at providing organized, safe parking for vehicles, encouraging use of transit, carpools, vanpools and other high occupancy modes (reduce reliance on single occupancy vehicles - SOV)
- Essential in efforts to meet federal, state, regional and local goals for reducing single occupant vehicle travel
- State Funding Participation is typically provided at 50%
- Park and ride lots serve as intermodal facilities and should be designed to facilitate transfer between modes.
