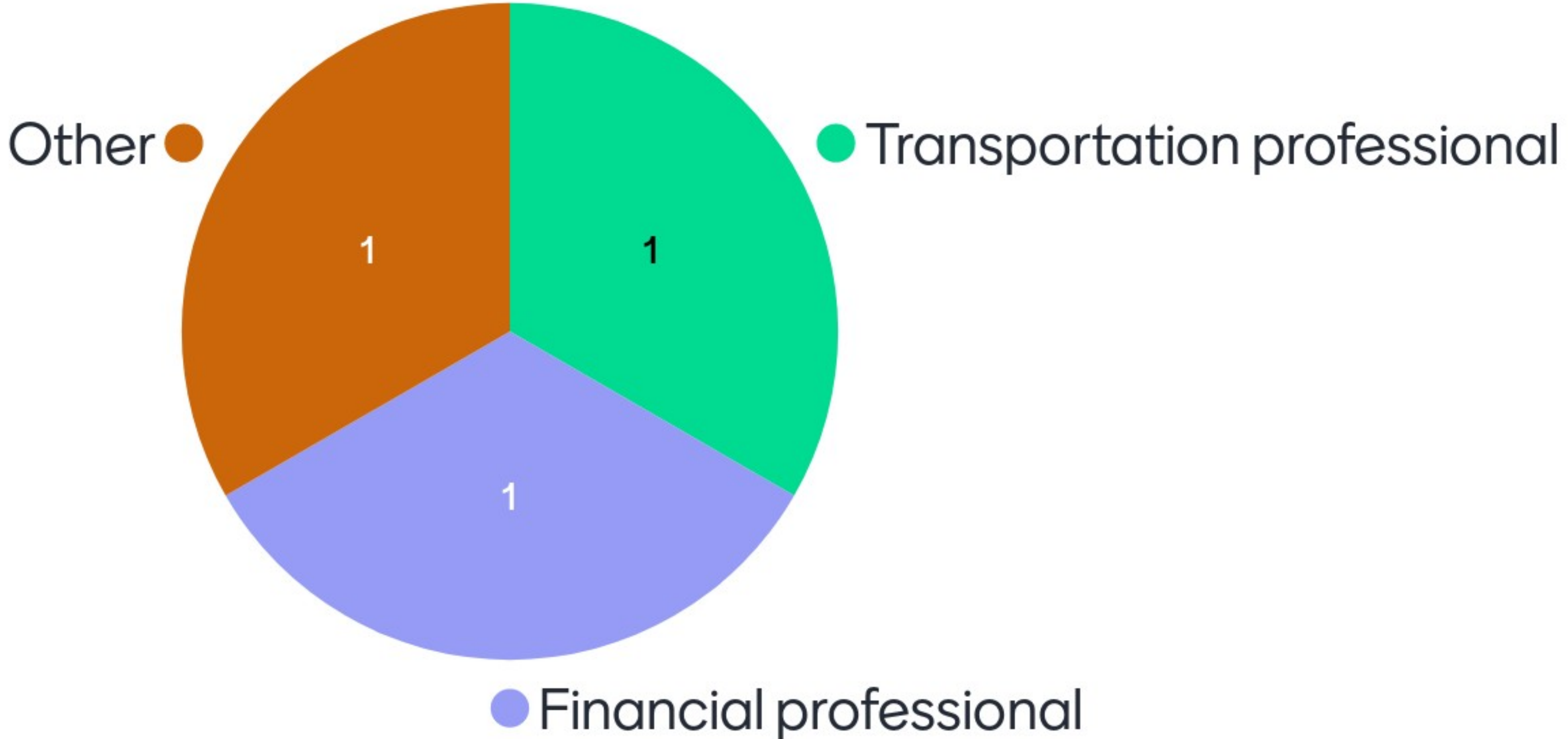

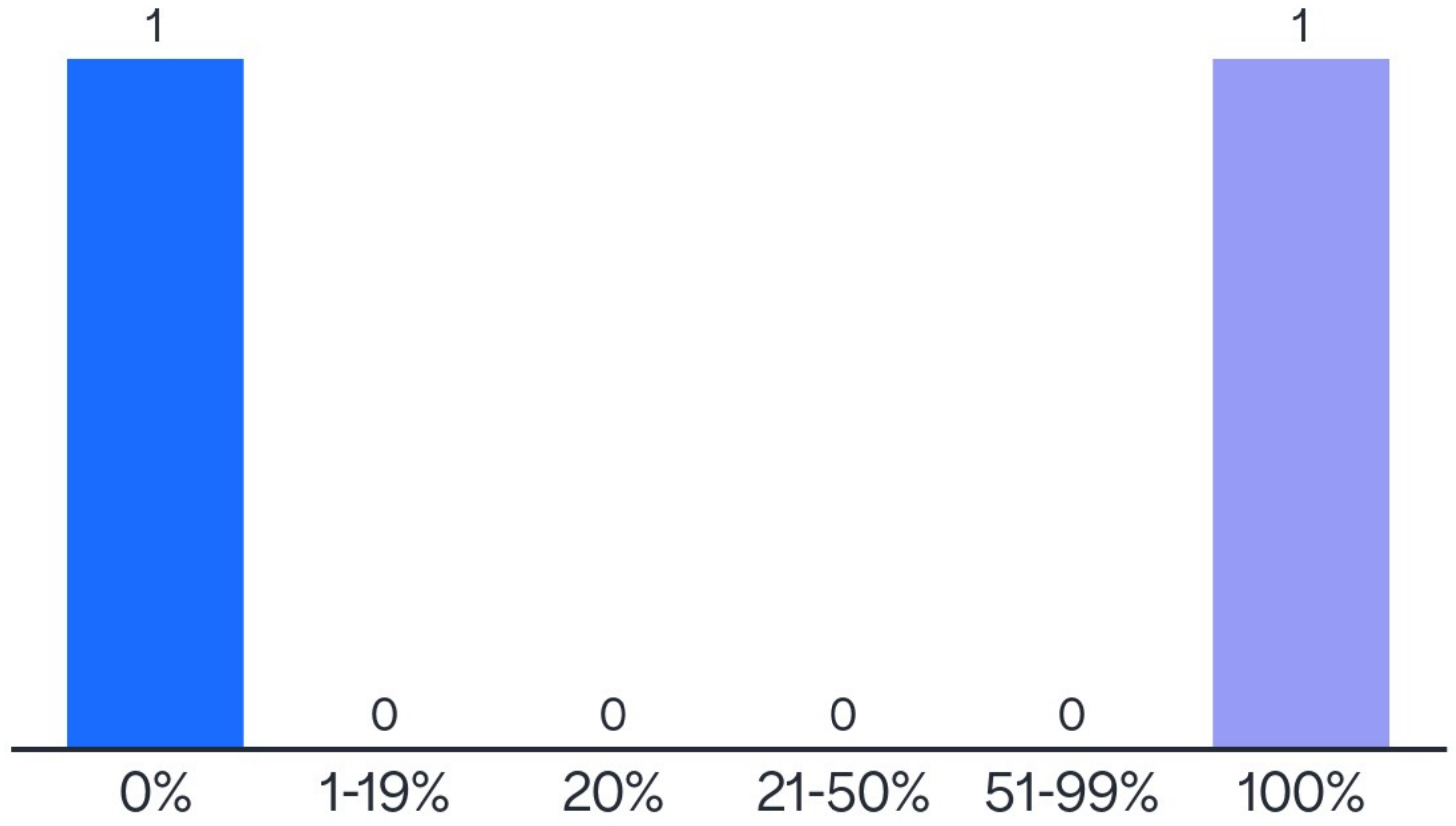

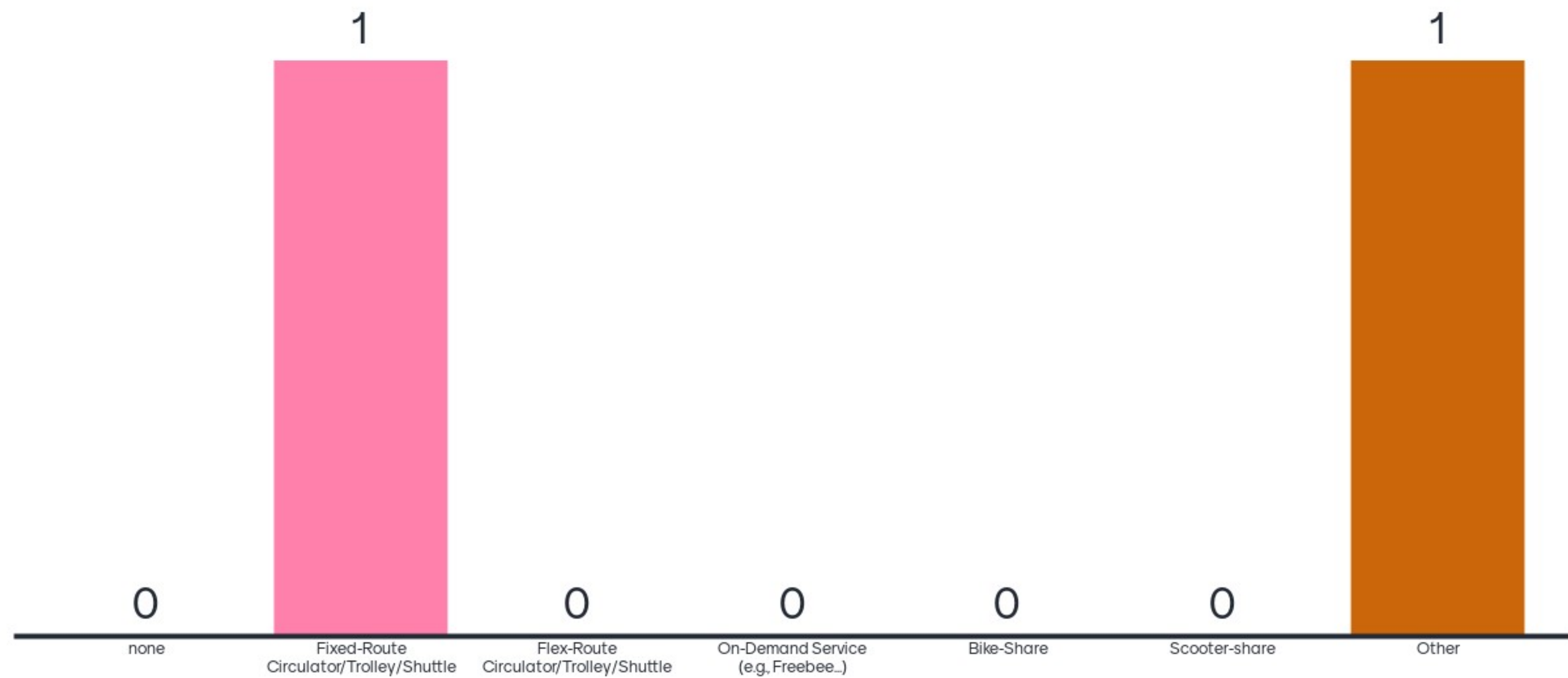

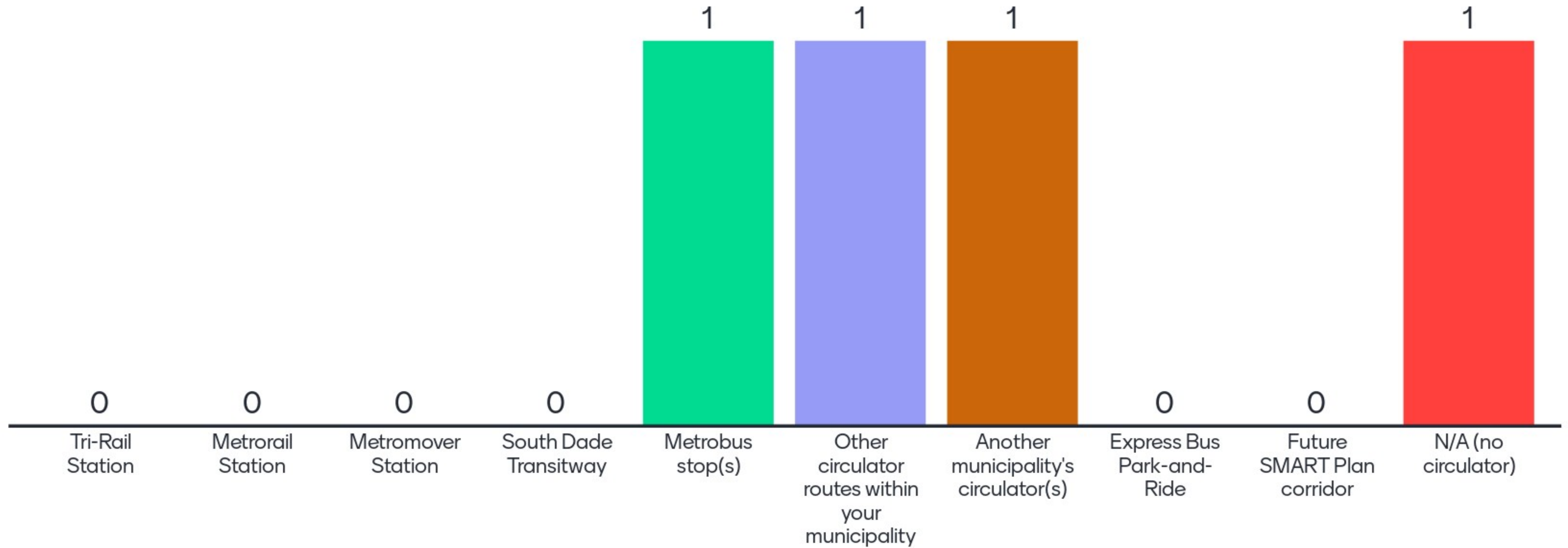
What is the % of your municipality's surtax dollars currently dedicated to transit?



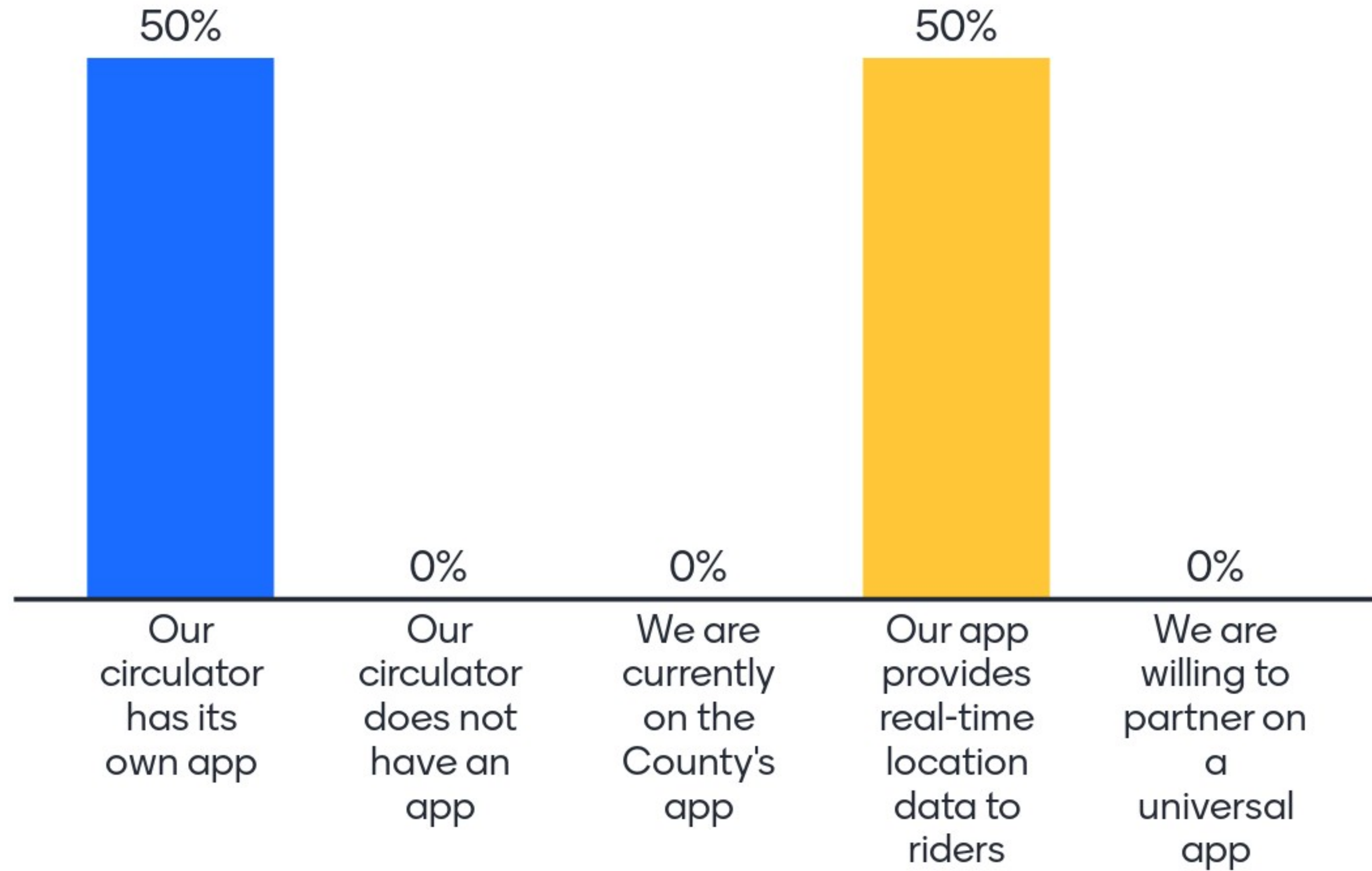

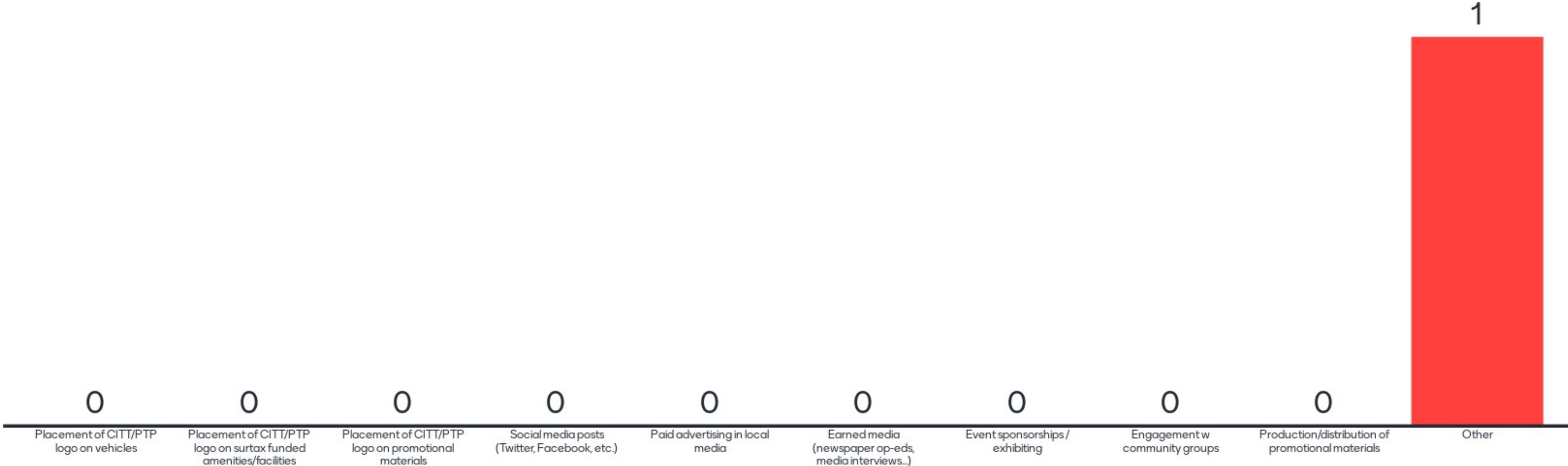

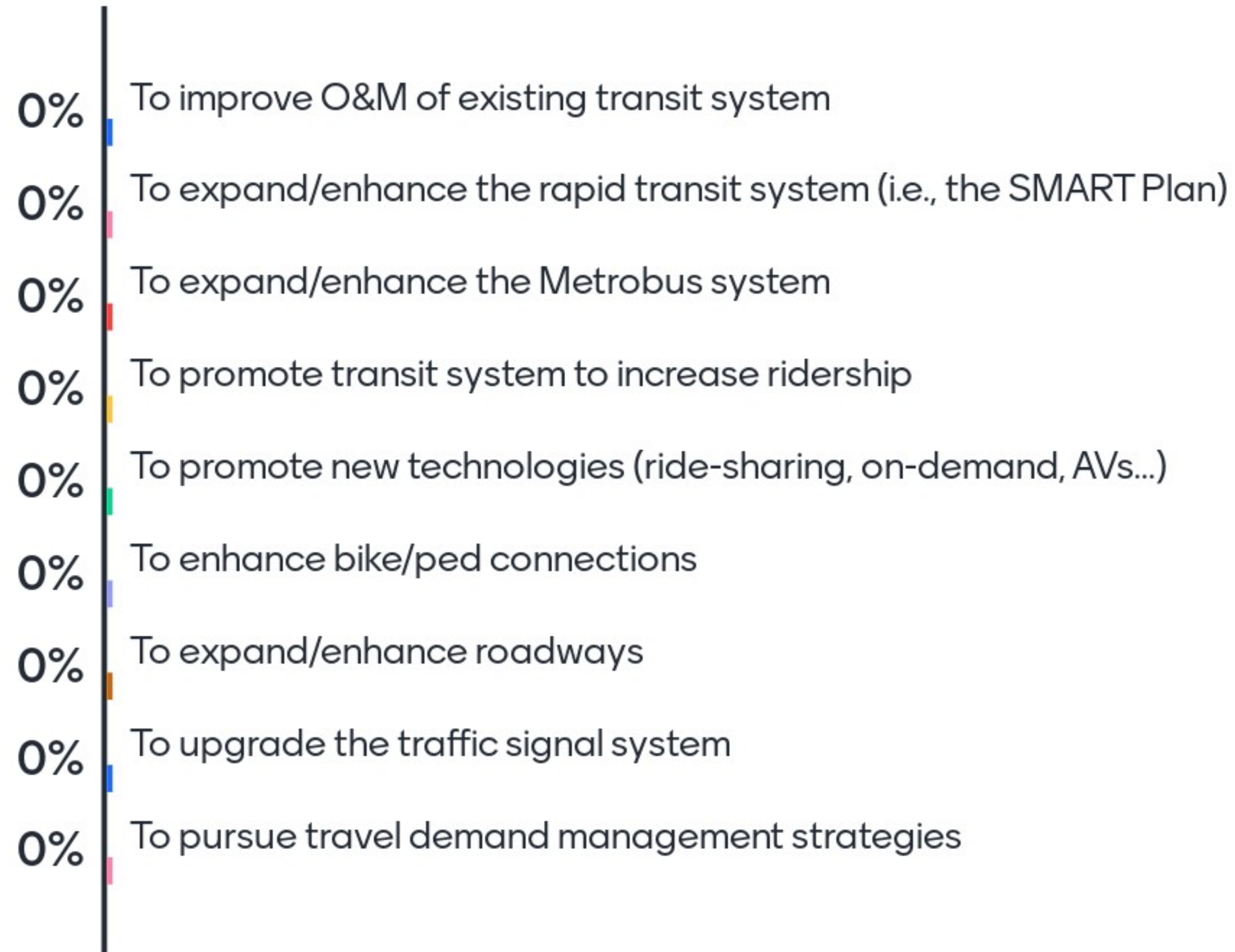

During COVID-19, our municipality...



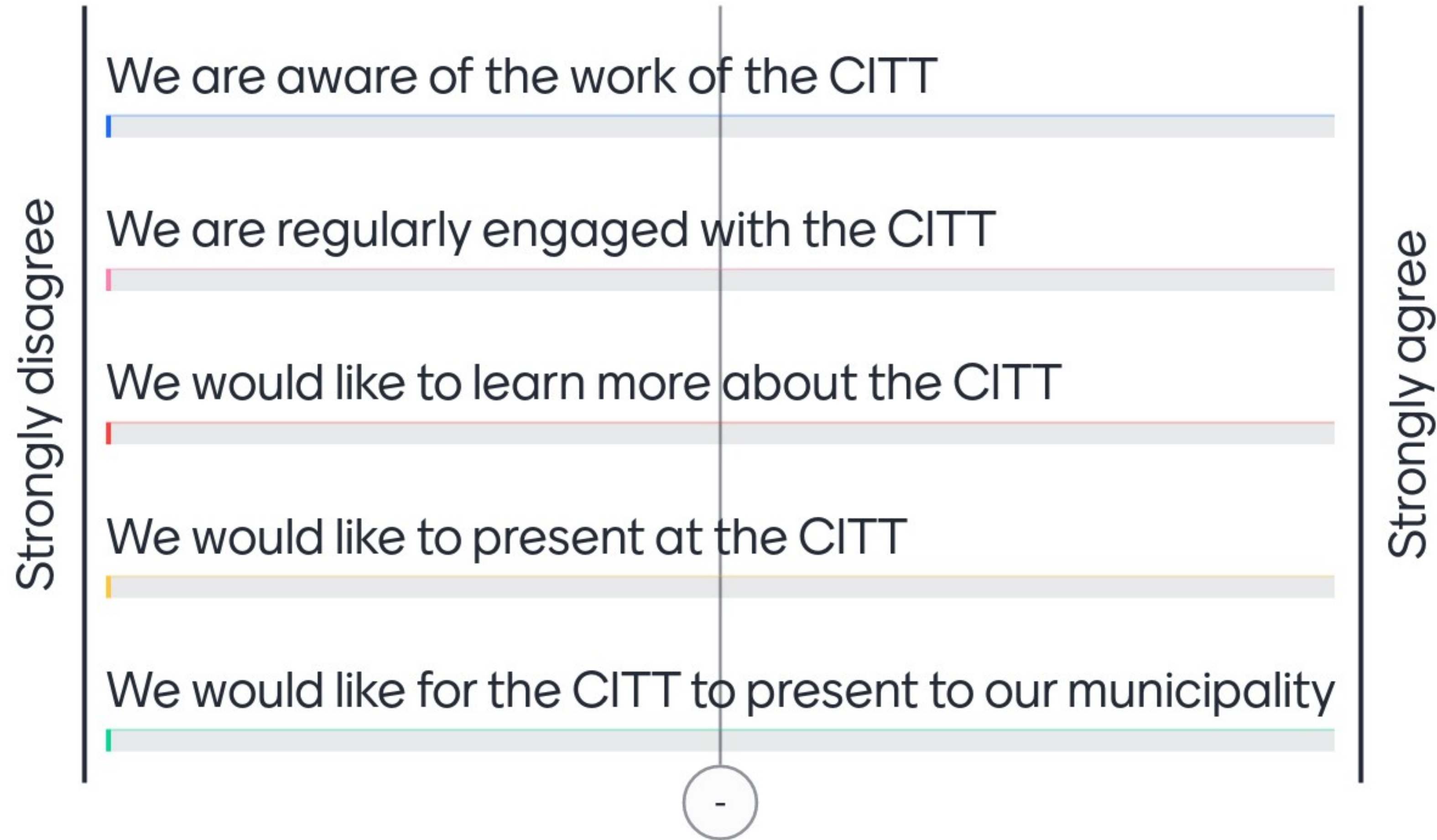
- Suspended our transit service temporarily

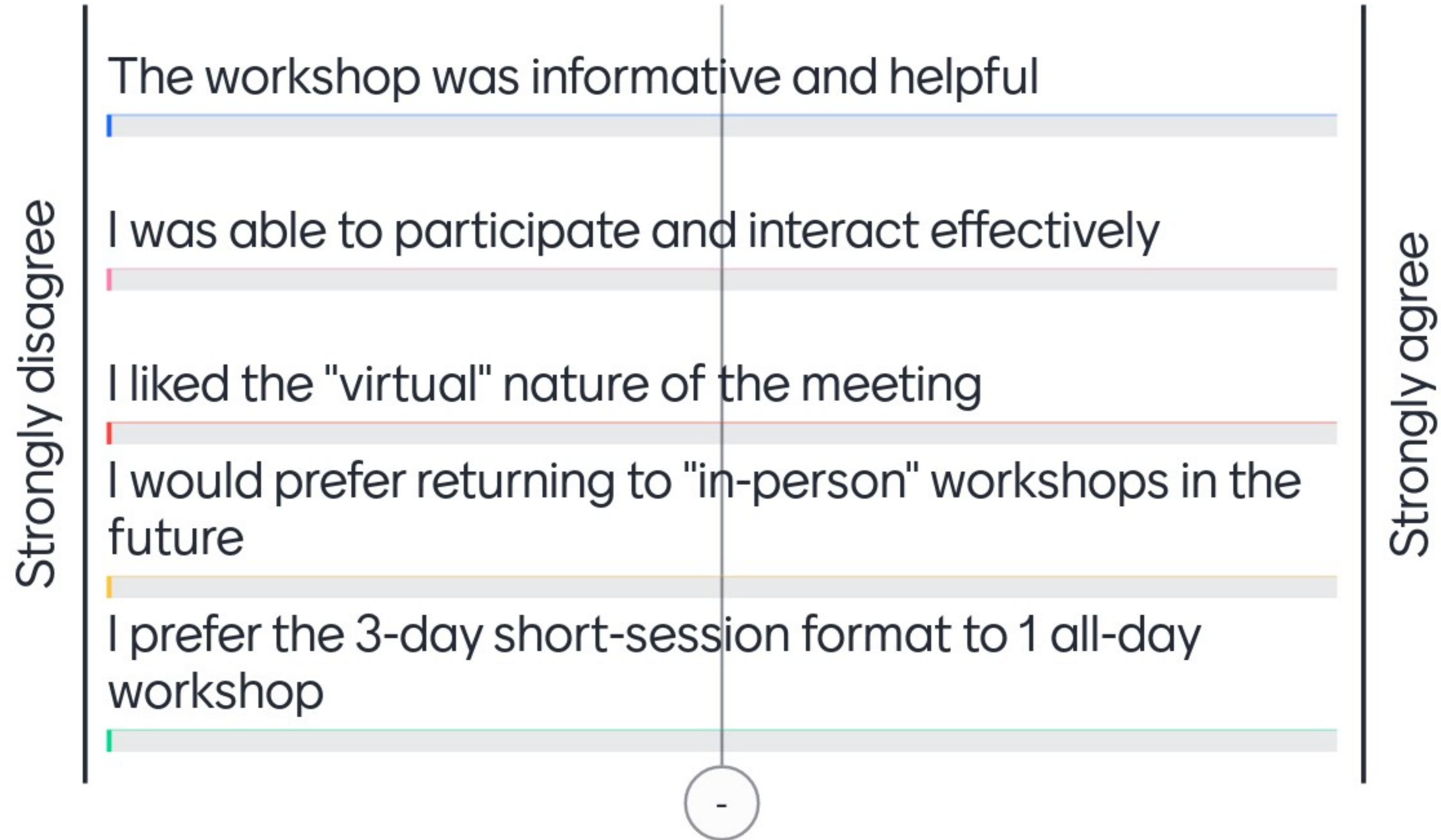
