

ORDINANCE NO. 14-11

ORDINANCE RELATING TO VEHICLES FOR HIRE;
AMENDING CHAPTER 31 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-
DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, TO PROVIDE THAT
MODEL YEAR 2005 TAXICABS SCHEDULED FOR
RETIREMENT ON DECEMBER 31, 2013 SHALL BE
ALLOWED TO BE OPERATED UNTIL JUNE 30, 2014;
PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE
CODE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:**

Section 1. Chapter 31 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby
amended to read as follows:¹

CHAPTER 31

VEHICLES FOR HIRE

ARTICLE II. LICENSING AND REGULATION OF
FOR-HIRE MOTOR VEHICLES.

Sec. 31-93. Special provisions.

* * *

- (e) Notwithstanding the vehicle age limits required by Sections 31-82(l)(4), 31-89(f) and 31-93(c)(3) of the Code, any properly permitted and inspected taxicab scheduled for retirement on December 31, 2012 shall be allowed to be operated for an

additional one-year period. >>Notwithstanding the vehicle age limits required by Sections 31-82(1)(4), 31-89(f) and 31-93(c)(3) of the Code, any properly permitted and inspected model year 2005 taxicab scheduled for retirement on December 31, 2013 shall be allowed to be operated until June 30, 2014. No further extensions shall be granted<<.

* * *

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.


Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
