



ORDINANCE NO. 15-121

ORDINANCE RELATING TO COMMISSION ON ETHICS AND PUBLIC TRUST; CREATING SECTION 2-1077 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSION ON ETHICS AND PUBLIC TRUST TO ENFORCE THE PUBLIC SERVICE HONOR CODE WHEN APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN THE FORM OF AN IMPLEMENTING ORDER; EMPOWERING THE COMMISSION ON ETHICS AND PUBLIC TRUST TO ISSUE LETTERS OF INSTRUCTION AND LETTERS OF REPRIMAND FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE HONOR CODE COMMITTED BY ELECTED COUNTY OFFICIALS AND ALL OTHER COUNTY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES NOT SUBJECT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE MAYOR; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA:

Section 1. Chapter 2, Section 2-1077 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, is hereby created to read as follows:

CHAPTER 2. ADMINISTRATION

>>**Sec. 2-1077.** **Authorizing Commission on Ethics and Public Trust to Enforce the Public Service Honor Code.**

Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the Miami-Dade Commission on Ethics and Public Trust shall be authorized to enforce the Public Service Honor Code ("Honor Code") when such Honor Code is approved by the Board of County Commissioners in the form of an implementing order. The Commission on Ethics and Public Trust shall be empowered to issue letters of instruction

and letters of reprimand for violations of the Honor Code committed by elected County officials and all other County officials and employees not subject to the administrative authority of the Mayor.<<

Section 2. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this ordinance is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance, including any sunset provision, shall become and be made a part of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The sections of this ordinance may be renumbered or relettered to accomplish such intention, and the word "ordinance" may be changed to "section," "article," or other appropriate word.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of enactment unless vetoed by the Mayor, and if vetoed, shall become effective only upon an override by this Board.
