RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board approve the application of Excel Transportation, Inc. to modify existing Passenger Motor Carrier (PMC) Certificate of Transportation No. 123 for the provision of jitney service.

SCOPE

This PMC Carrier Certificate of Transportation is countywide, allowing the license holder to operate in unincorporated and incorporated areas of Miami-Dade County.

FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

There is no fiscal impact to the County.

TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

The principal of the company, Mr. Yves Polynice, has been a licensed permit holder since 1992. There has been some enforcement within the last five years. Between April 2003 and August 2005, the company and its drivers received two citations, one vehicle deficiency and five vehicle suspensions. All violations were satisfied timely. There have been no further enforcement actions. The Consumer Services Department will be responsible for monitoring this company.

BACKGROUND

On February 17, 1981, the Board adopted Ordinance 81-17, subsequently amended by Ordinance 85-20 on April 16, 1985, Ordinance 98-123 on September 3, 1998, and Ordinance No. 02-1 on January 29, 2002, which regulates the passenger motor carrier industry in Miami-Dade County under Chapter 31 of the Code of Miami-Dade County.

Section 31-103 (m) of the Code provides the procedures to be followed by the County in processing certificate applications. No certificate may be sold, assigned or transferred to another until the proposed sale, assignment or transfer has been approved by the Board. In considering the proposed modification of the certificate, the Board shall determine whether or not said modification is contrary to the public interest, upon evidence submitted at the September 10, 2008 Economic Development and Human Services Committee meeting (Attachment A). The Board may approve or refuse to approve the modification of certificate upon such terms and conditions or may reasonably alter, restrict or modify the terms and provisions if in the public's best interest. In reaching its determination, the EDHS Committee and Board shall consider the application, the County Manager's report and recommendation, all matters presented at the public hearing, and among others the following criteria:

- (1) That the applicant is fit, willing and able, in accordance with the requirements of this section, to provide the transportation to be authorized by this certificate and is able to comply with this article and regulations of the Board.
- (2) That the transportation to be provided under the requested certificate is consistent with the public interest.
- (3) That the proposed transportation service will improve the quality of transportation available to the public.
- (4) That, if applying for jitney or fixed route authority, the proposed transportation will not adversely affect the existing transportation system as a whole or future planned transit service as designated in the most current Miami-Dade Transportation Plan. In particular, it shall be deemed not in the public interest to authorize certificates of transportation for service on actual transit or passenger motor carrier corridors where service presently exists at average frequencies of 29 minutes or less and/or where such service will impair special transportation provided by the passenger motor carrier industry.

Mr. Yves Polynice, President of Excel Transportation, Inc., located at 1665 NW 121 Street, Miami, Florida 33168, seeks to modify PMC Certificate of Transportation No. 123, to provide expanded jitney service. This class of service is defined as any motor vehicle having a maximum seating capacity of 15 or less, transporting passengers for compensation on a semi-fixed route between fixed terminals not on a fixed schedule basis. The existing route has been operated by the applicant since approval was granted by the Board in 1992. The route modification includes an extension to the north. The Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) Service and Mobility Planning Division determined that the proposed route modification is in compliance with the criteria of Section 31-103 (g)(4) of the Miami-Dade County Code (Attachment B).

Excel is required to adhere to the terms of Resolutions R-1304-92 (Attachment C) and R-259-98 (Attachment D). Excel will continue transporting passengers for compensation on a semi-fixed route between fixed terminals not on a fixed schedule. Transportation will be provided using chauffeur driven vehicles with a seating capacity of at least nine or more, excluding the driver, seven days a week, from 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. The proposed rates are \$1.25 per person, one-way.

The management plan submitted by Mr. Yves Polynice, President of Excel Transportation, Inc., includes maintenance, communication, and record keeping systems and meets the requirements of the Code. All required financial statements and credit references have been submitted and the proposed service standards adequately meet passenger transportation and comfort needs. A background investigation reveals no criminal conviction for the applicant or any corporate officers within five years of the date of the application.

The applicant expressed during this time period that its existing route is not financially viable. In fact, this applicant has been attempting to modify its route since March 21, 2002. MDT rejected several routes that did not meet the 30 percent route duplication standard. Several protests were also filed which delayed the application process. In September 2007, the applicant submitted a revised route to MDT which was approved in January 2008.

In accordance with Section 31-103(e) of the Code, a 20-day notice of application was provided to all affected municipalities within Miami-Dade County, all passenger motor carrier certificate holders and interested parties affording them an opportunity to protest the application. No protests were filed.

As requested per your memo of December 13, 2007, the Service and Mobility Planning Division of Miami-Dade Transit (MDT) analyzed, in accordance with Section 31-103(g)(4) of the Miami-Dade County Code, the new jitney route alignment modification proposal filed with the Consumer Services Department (CSD) by Mr. Polynice d/b/a Excel Transportation Inc. The proposed alignment would connect the CBD to the NE Miami-Dade area (NE 159 Street and West Dixie Highway) via mainly NW 2 Avenue, N. Miami Avenue and NE 159 Street.

The results of the analysis show that 30% of the new jitney route alignment proposed by Excel Transportation Inc. duplicates Miami-Dade Transit and authorized jitney service. The maximum percentage of duplication allowed for compliance with the Miami-Dade County Code is 30%.

Based on these results Miami-Dade Transit has found that the modified route proposed by Excel Transportation is in compliance with the criteria established in Section 31-103(g)(4) of the Miami-Dade County Code, as amended by the new Ordinance No. 02.1 relating to Regulation of Passenger Motor Vehicle Carriers.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board, at the conclusion of the public hearing, consider the application of Excel Transportation, Inc., d/b/a Excel Jitney, Inc., and approve the certificate as requested.

BACKGROUND:

On February 17, 1981, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 81-17, subsequently amended by Ordinance 85-20 on April 16, 1985, which regulates the Passenger Motor Carrier Industry in Dade County under Chapter 31 of the Code of Metropolitan Dade County.

Section 31-103 of the Code provides the procedure to be followed by Metropolitan Dade County in processing certificate applications. Based on these requirements, a public hearing has been scheduled before the Board of County Commissioners. At the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board may issue or refuse to issue the certificate or issue it with such modifications or upon such terms and conditions as in its judgment the public interest may require. In reaching its determination, the Board shall consider the application, the County Manager's report and recommendation, all matters presented at the public hearing, and among others, the following criteria:

- (1) That the applicant is fit, willing and able in accordance with the requirements of this section, to provide the transportation to be authorized by the certificate, and is able to comply with this article and regulation of the commission.
- (2) That the transportation to be provided under the requested certificate is consistent with the public interest.
- (3) That the proposed transportation service will improve the quality of transportation available to the public.
- (4) That, if applying for jitney or fixed route authority,

the proposed transportation will not adversely affect the existing transportation system as a whole or future planned transit service as designated in the most current Metro-Dade Transportation Plan. In particular, it shall be deemed not in the public interest to authorize certificate of transportation for service on actual transit or passenger motor carrier corridors where service presently exists at frequencies of thirty (30) minutes or less and/or where such service will impair special transportation provided by the passenger motor carrier industry.

ANALYSIS:

Excel Transportation, Inc., d/b/a/ Excel Jitney, Inc., located at 1665 N.W. 121 Street, Miami, Florida 33167, seeks to obtain a Passenger Motor Carrier Certificate of Transportation to provide jitney transportation service on a semi-fixed route as follows: Starting at the corner of N.E. 127th Street and N.E. 14th Avenue, west on N.E. 127th Street to N.E. 10th Avenue, north on N.E. 10th Avenue to N.E. 159th Street, west on N.E. 159th Street to N.W. 2nd Avenue, south on N.W. 2nd Avenue along the Memorial Highway corridor to North Miami Avenue, south on North Miami Avenue to N.W. 146 Street, west on N.W. 146 Street to N.W. 2nd Avenue, south on N.W. 2nd Avenue to N.W. 86 Street, west on N.W. 86 Street to N.W. 5 Avenue, north on N.W. 5 Avenue to N.W. 146 Street, east on N.W. 146 Street to North Miami Avenue and return. * Serves only in one direction from: N.W. 146 Street and 2nd, south to N.W. 86 Street and N.W. 2nd Avenue, and from N.W. 87 Street, N.W. 5 Avenue to N.W. 146 Street and N.W. 5 Avenue. Hours and days of operation are 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., seven days a week, using vehicles with a seating capacity of nine to fifteen (15) passengers excluding the driver, with rates at \$1.00 per person one-way.

The management plan submitted by the applicant indicates that the business facility includes maintenance, communication, and record keeping systems and meets the requirements of the Code. All required financial statements and credit references have been submitted and the proposed service standards adequately meet passenger transportation and comfort needs. A background investigation revealed no criminal record for the applicant.

A Metro Dade Transit Agency analysis shows little or no conflict with existing jitney services or duplication of Metrobus service. The MDTA analysis determined that the proposed route is in compliance with the criteria of Section 31-103(g)4 of the Metropolitan Dade County Code.



ARTICLE III. PASSENGER MOTOR CARRIERS*

Sec. 31-101. Transportation policy.

To assure the development and maintenance of a safe, healthy and efficient passenger transportation system for Dade County, the commission, county manager and county staff, in carrying out the duties and responsibilities prescribed in this article, shall consider the following as being in the public interest:

- (1) Reliance on market forces and on actual and potential competition among all transportation modes, so as to provide transportation services at competitive prices.
- (2) Coordination of regulatory decision-making with the transportation improvement plan, and the orderly development of an integrated transportation/transit system for Dade County so as to ensure the development and maintenance of a transportation/transit system responsive to the needs of the public, in which regulatory decisions are reached fairly and expeditiously, and with consideration of their costs and benefits.
- (3) Improvement of motor vehicle safety.
- (4) Achievement of county, national and state energy conservation goals.
- (5) Reduced concentration of market power, and prevention of unfair, deceptive, predatory or anticompetitive practices.
- (6) Reduction of restrictive regulatory barriers to entry into the industry and promotion of equal opportunities.
- (7) Promotion of the safety and welfare of the residents and visitors of Dade County who use the services of passenger motor carriers to meet their transportation needs.
- (8) Recognition that a strong, viable, private sector passenger motor carrier industry has a role in efforts to improve

It is recommended that the Board approve the application of Excel Transportation, Inc. d/b/a Excel Jitney, Inc. to modify and extend Passenger Motor Carrier Certificate of Transportation No. 123, authorized by R-1304-92, to provide jitney service.

BACKGROUND

On February 17, 1981, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 81-17, subsequently amended by Ordinance 85-20 on April 16, 1985, which regulates the passenger motor carrier industry in Dade County under Chapter 31 of the Code of Metropolitan Dade County.

Section 31-103 of the Code provides the procedures to be followed by Metro-Dade County in processing certificate applications. Based on those requirements, a public hearing has been scheduled before the Board of County Commissioners. At the conclusion of the public hearing, the Board may issue or refuse to issue the certificate, or issue the certificate with such modifications or upon such terms and conditions as in its judgment the public interest may require. In reaching its determination, the Board shall consider the application, the County Manager's report and recommendation, all matters presented at the public hearing, and among others, the following criteria:

- (1) That the applicant is fit, willing and able in accordance with the requirements of this section, to provide the transportation to be authorized by this certificate and is able to comply with this article and regulations of the commission.
- (2) That the transportation to be provided under the requested certificate is consistent with the public interest.
- (3) That the proposed transportation service will improve the quality of transportation available to the public.
- (4) That, if applying for jitney or fixed route authority, the proposed transportation will not adversely affect the existing transportation system as a whole or future planned transit service as designated in the most current Metro-Dade.

Transportation Plan. In particular, it shall be deemed not in the public interest to authorize a certificate of transportation for service on actual transit or passenger motor carrier corridors where service presently exists at frequencies of thirty (30) minutes or less and/or where such service will impair special transportation provided by the passenger motor carrier industry.

ANALYSIS

Excel Transportation, Inc. d/b/a Excel Jitney, Inc., located at 1665 NW 121 Street, Miami, Florida 33167, seeks to modify Passenger Motor Carrier Certificate of Transportation No. 123 to provide expanded jitney transportation service. This is an existing route which has been operated by the applicant since approval was granted by the Board in 1992. The route modification, which is attached, eliminates some areas and extends service from NW 86 Street to downtown Miami. The total route will be 22 miles. The Metro-Dade Transit Agency (MDTA) analysis determined that the proposed route modification is in compliance with the criteria of Section 31-103 (g) (4) of the Metropolitan Dade County Code.

Transportation services will be provided using chauffeur driven vehicles with a seating capacity of at least nine (9) or more, but no more than 15 passengers, excluding the driver, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m., seven days a week. The proposed rates are \$1.25 per person, one way. The management plan submitted by Mr. Yves Polynice, President of Excel Transportation, Inc., includes maintenance, communication, and record keeping systems and meets the requirements of the Code. All required financial statements and credit references have been submitted and the proposed service standards adequately meet passenger transportation and comfort needs. A background investigation reveals no criminal record for the applicant.

In accordance with Section 31-103 (e) of the Code, a 20-day notice of application was provided to all affected municipalities within Dade County, all existing PMC Certificate Holders and interested parties affording them an opportunity to protest the application. Five protests were filed by: Liberty City Jitney, Alphe Willingham, Dade Jitney, Alto Screen, and Ernest Johnson. The protesters allege conflict of the applicant's route with their existing jitney routes. Liberty City Jitney and Dade Jitney allege that the proposed route extension filed by Excel Transportation is within close proximity of their existing routes and that it effectively provides no new service for which a need has been identified.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Code, an administrative hearing was conducted during which the Hearing Examiner received comments from the above-named protesters. The Hearing Examiner recommended denial of the protest as indicated in the Hearing Examiner's report. Staff concurred with the recommendation of the Hearing Examiner and prepared the item for Commission consideration.

Subsequently, staff met with the applicant and the protesters to determine if the latter continued to have concerns regarding the applicant's route. The protesters requested that a revision be made in the downtown area of the proposed route. The applicant agreed and modified the route. MDTA determined that the modification is in compliance with the criteria of Section 31-103 (g) (4) of the Metropolitan Dade County Code. Because the applicant modified his route, the protesters agreed, in writing, to withdraw their protest of the application. A copy of the agreement is attached.

The applicant's citation history is concentrated in the period of March through December, 1993. There is no current citation history.
