

RESOLUTION NO. R-1004-11

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO ALLOW MIAMI-DADE TRANSIT EMPLOYEES WHO ARE MEMBERS OF THE CONFERENCE OF MINORITY TRANSPORTATION OFFICIALS TO ELECT TO HAVE THEIR MEMBERSHIP DUES DEDUCTED FROM THEIR PAYROLL ACCOUNT; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PERIODICALLY TRANSFER SUCH DEDUCTIONS THE CONFERENCE OF MINORITY TRANSPORTATION OFFICIALS AND, IF NECESSARY, ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CONFERENCE OF MINORITY TRANSPORTATION OFFICIALS EFFECTUATING SUCH TRANSFER

**WHEREAS,** The mission of COMTO is to ensure a level playing field and maximum participation in the transportation industry for minority individuals, businesses and communities of color through advocacy, information sharing, training, education and professional development; and

**WHEREAS,** allowing employees who are members of COMTO to elect to have their dues deducted from their payroll account would facilitate membership in this valuable organization,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA,** that:

**Section 1.** The matters contained in the foregoing recitals are incorporated in this Resolution by reference.

**Section 2.** The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is hereby directed to allow Miami-Dade transit employees who are members of the conference of minority transportation officials to elect to have their membership dues deducted from their payroll.

**Section 3.** The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is hereby authorized to periodically transfer the deductions from the employee's payroll account into an account designated by COMTO and, if necessary, upon consultation with the County Attorney's Office, enter into an agreement with COMTO effectuating such transfer.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Bruno A. Barreiro. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
