RESOLUTION NO. R-1009-11

RESOLUTION APPROVING ALLOCATION OF \$1.5 MILLION FROM BUILDING BETTER COMMUNITIES GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND PROGRAM PROJECT NUMBER 220 – “ACQUIRE OR CONSTRUCT MULTI-PURPOSE FACILITIES” TO FUND DEVELOPMENT OF MULTI-PURPOSE FACILITY BY CITY OF MIAMI

WHEREAS, Appendix A to Resolution No. R-917-04 lists projects eligible for funding from the Building Better Communities General Obligation Bond (“BBC GOB”) Program by project number, municipal project location, BCC district, project name, project description, street address and allocation; and

WHEREAS, one of the projects listed in Appendix A to Resolution No. R-917-04 is BCC GOB Program Project No. 220 – “Acquire or Construct Multi-Purpose Facilities”, located in BCC district 6 and a total project allocation of \$15,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami (the “City”) wishes to develop a multi-purpose facility, approximately 4,500 square feet in size, that would include meeting rooms, multi-purpose rooms, space for after-school, cultural and arts programs, all to be constructed, operated and maintained by the City (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the Project will be developed by the City in District 6 at 5135 NW 7th Street, Miami, FL 33126 in the Antonio Maceo Park area; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to allocate \$1.5 million from BCC GOB Program Project No. 220 – “Acquire or Construct Multi-Purpose Facilities” to fund a portion of the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City shall be responsible for the completion, operation and maintenance of the Project,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board finds that the Project is a “multi-purpose facility” eligible for funding from BCC GOB Program Project No. 220 – “Acquire or Construct Multi-Purpose Facilities” and approves the allocation of \$1.5 million from BBC GOB Program Project Number 220 for the construction of the Project.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner **Rebeca Sosa**, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Sally A. Heyman** and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
