

RESOLUTION NO. R-1011-14

RESOLUTION DIRECTING MAYOR OR MAYOR'S  
DESIGNEE TO IDENTIFY THE ROADWAYS WITHIN  
MIAMI-DADE COUNTY IN NEED OF ILLUMINATION

**WHEREAS**, illuminated roadways provide enhanced safety for drivers, passengers, bicyclists, and pedestrians; and

**WHEREAS**, illuminated roadways increase security from crime; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to remain informed as to the progress of efforts to provide illuminated roadways,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that the Mayor or Mayor's designee is directed to identify those roadways within Miami-Dade County in need of illumination and report said findings to the Board. In determining areas of need for illumination, the Mayor or Mayor's designee is further directed to consider traffic usage, traffic accident statistics, and crime rates. The Mayor or Mayor's designee shall provide the report to this Board within 90 days of the effective date of this resolution and shall place the completed report on an agenda of the Board pursuant to Ordinance No. 14-65.
