## Recommendation

The following plat is submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners for approval. The plat of Shoppes on the Avenue is bounded on the north approximately 140 feet south of SW 224 Street, on the east by SW 112 Avenue, on the south approximately 280 feet north of SW 226 Street, and on the west approximately 340 feet east of SW 112 Place.

The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee (Plat Committee) recommends approval and recording of this plat. The Plat Committee is comprised of representatives from:

- Florida Department of Transportation;
- Florida Department of Health;
- Miami-Dade County School Board; and
- Miami-Dade County departments of Fire Rescue; Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces; Regulatory and Economic Resources (RER); Transportation and Public Works; and Water and Sewer.

## Scope

This plat is located in Commission District 9, which is represented by Commissioner Dennis C. Moss.

## Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

There is no associated fiscal impact to Miami-Dade County with the approval of this plat as all improvements are in place.

## Track Record/Monitor

The Development Services Division of RER administers the processing of plats and waivers of plat, and the person responsible for this function is Raul A. Pino, P. L. S.

## Background

Shoppes on the Avenue (T-23605)

- Located in Section 18, Township 56 South, Range 40 East
- Zoning: BU-1A
- Proposed Usage: Retail store
- Number of parcels: 1
- This plat meets concurrency.

**Plat Restrictions**

- That SW 112 Avenue (South Allapattah Road), as illustrated on the plat, together with all existing and future planting, trees, shrubbery and fire hydrants thereon, are hereby dedicated to the perpetual use of the public for proper purposes, reserving to the dedicators, their successors and assigns the reversion or reversions thereof, whenever discontinued by law.
- That individual wells shall not be permitted within this subdivision, except for swimming pools, sprinkler systems and/or air conditioners.
- That the use of septic tanks will not be permitted within this subdivision, unless approved for temporary use, in accordance with County and State regulations.
- That all new electric and communication lines, except transmission lines, within this subdivision, shall be installed underground.

**Developer's Obligation**

- None, all improvements are in place.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF SHOPPES ON THE AVENUE, LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 18, TOWNSHIP 56 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH APPROXIMATELY 140 FEET SOUTH OF SW 224 STREET, ON THE EAST BY SW 112 AVENUE, ON THE SOUTH APPROXIMATELY 280 FEET NORTH OF SW 226 STREET, AND ON THE WEST APPROXIMATELY 340 FEET EAST OF SW 112 PLACE)

WHEREAS, SW112DG, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as Shoppes on the Avenue, the same being a subdivision of a portion of land lying and being in the Southwest 1/4 of Section 18, Township 56 South, Range 40 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that said plat is hereby approved; that the dedication of the streets, alleys and other rights-of-way however designated or depicted on said plat is hereby accepted; that the Miami-Dade County Plat Restrictions as listed on said plat are approved and are to be enforced; that approval of the plat is not a waiver of any zoning regulations and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this resolution is approved shall be enforced whether or not the various parcels on this plat conform to those requirements.
