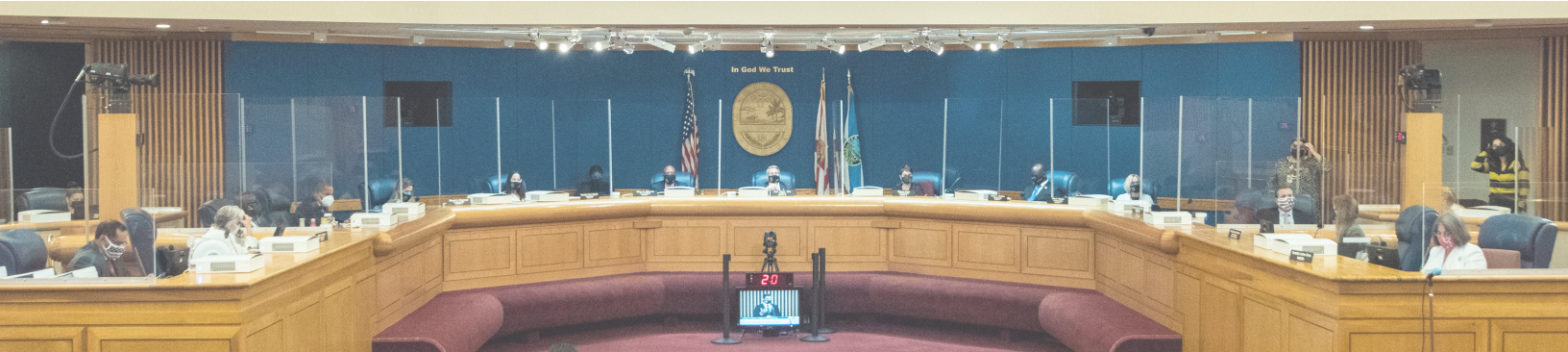




THE BCC BULLETIN

Some Highlights from the November 2 and 16, 2021, Commission Meetings



Among the County Items:

- **Resolution** urging the United States Congress to adopt S.2756 and H.R. 5142 or similar legislation to award the Congressional Gold Medal to the 13 servicemembers killed on August 26, 2021, at the Hamid Karzai International Airport in Kabul, Afghanistan. -- ***Passed***
- **Resolution** creating a working group to develop an implementation plan for an urban air mobility system in Miami-Dade County. -- ***Passed***
- **Ordinance** relating to animals that constitute animal cruelty, increasing civil penalties for certain animal cruelty violations. -- ***Passed***
- **Resolution** authorizing affiliating agreements with Miami-Dade County Public Schools for the provision of educational classes for juveniles and special educational classes for young adults in the custody of the Miami-Dade Corrections and Rehabilitation Department. -- ***Passed***
- **Resolution** urging the Florida Legislature to enact legislation that would provide further property tax relief for certain low-income senior citizens. -- ***Passed***
- **Ordinance** relating to job creation incentives for businesses, creating the Miami-Dade Relocation and Expansion Incentives Program to provide financial incentives to certain expanding and new-to-market businesses in Miami-Dade County. -- ***Passed***
- **Resolution** urging the United States Congress to adopt S.2990, H.R.5557, the Democracia Act, or similar legislation to support freedom and democracy for the people of Cuba and to restrict or reduce the financial resources of the Cuban dictatorship. -- ***Passed***
- **Resolution** urging the Florida Legislature to offer funds for the Westchester Cultural Arts Center. -- ***Passed***
- **Resolution** urging the Florida Legislature to adopt Senate Memorial 302 and House Memorial 63 or similar legislation urging the United States Congress to recognize the epidemic of suicide among veterans and fully fund suicide prevention efforts by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs. -- ***Passed***
