Some Highlights from the Jan. 17, 2023, Commission Meeting



Among the County Items:

- **Resolution** declaring certain firefighting equipment surplus, authorizing the donation of firefighting equipment to the Ghana National Fire Service and Accra Regional Command, and authorizing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute a foreign firefighting entity donation. **Passed**
- <u>Resolution</u> approving the co-designation of a portion of SW 162nd Ave., from SW 56th St. to SW 72nd St., as "Officer Cesar Echaverry Way." — <u>Passed</u>
- <u>Ordinance</u> changing the boundaries of the Town of Medley and amending the Town's municipal charter to provide for the annexation of certain lands. <u>Passed</u>
- <u>Resolution</u> urging the Florida legislature to appropriate funding for the Miami River Commission to continue the successful revitalization and sustained urban redevelopment of the Miami River and its surroundings. <u>Passed</u>
- <u>Resolution</u> urging the Florida legislature to provide funding to assist with septic-to-sewer conversions along State Rd. 976/Bird Rd., between SW 77th Ave. and SW 117th Ave., in Miami-Dade County. -- *Passed*
- <u>Ordinance</u> providing additional procedures related to certain Comprehensive Development Master Plan (CDMP) amendment applications and when certain types of CDMP amendment applications fail to receive number of votes required for adoption. *Passed*
- Resolution urging the Florida legislature to enact Senate Joint Resolution (SJR) 122 and Senate Bill (SB) 120 or similar legislation that would propose an amendment to the Florida constitution and amend Florida statutes, respectively, to revise the limitation on annual increases of homestead property tax assessments from 3% to 2%. Passed
- <u>Resolution</u> approving the City of Miami's co-designation of a portion of SW 25th St., from Douglas Rd./SW 37th Ave. to SW 36th Ave., as "Pedro Milian Street." -- <u>Passed</u>
