Some Highlights from the January 17, 2024 Commission Meeting



Among the County Items:

- **Resolution** directing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to collaborate with the City of Miami Gardens and the City of Miami Gardens Community Redevelopment Agency to provide technical assistance in the design and construction of the North Dade Cultural Arts Center. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** approving the issuance of revenue bonds by Arizona Industrial Development Authority in one or more series in an amount not to exceed \$30 million for capital projects to benefit charter school educational facilities of True North Classical Academy, Inc., located in Sunset, Gateway, and Dadeland. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** urging the Florida Legislature to appropriate funding for the Miami-Dade Department of Emergency Management. If approved, funding will allow the department the capability to deploy a command-and-control facility, expand the Community Emergency Response Team ("CERT") program, acquire a "box" truck to increase logistical capabilities to distribute disaster-related supplies and procure back-up emergency operations infrastructure and an operations center. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** urging the Florida Legislature to appropriate funding to facilitate the construction of improvements to the Roller Hockey Rink at the Palmetto Golf Course Facility. If approved, funding will support a metal roof structure, restrooms, storage space, parking lot reconfiguration, lighting, scoreboard, and six fans. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** urging the Florida Legislature to appropriate funding for the Badia Center Facility at Flagami Park. If approved, the funding will allow renovation and expansion of the Badia Center Facility and increase the variety of enrichment activities and social programs for seniors that the center provides. - **Passed**
- **Resolution** urging the United States Congress to support and maintain funding for the United States President's Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief ("PEPFAR") at current or greater levels to ensure the continuity of current and future HIV/AIDS prevention programs. If approved, funding will allow nonprofit organization partners of PEPFAR who provide medication to millions around the world, strengthen local and national healthcare systems, and care for children orphaned by AIDS. - **Passed**
