## Some Highlights from the March 5 & 19, 2024 Commission Meetings



## Among the County Items:

- <u>Resolution</u> ratifying the execution of a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between Miami-Dade County and the Miami Downtown Development Authority (DDA) for the provision of \$100,000 toward the construction of a dog spot at the ground level of the First Street Metromover Station. - *Passed*
- <u>Resolution</u> directing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to develop a plan to illuminate County buildings with green lights for Mental Health Awareness Month. – *Passed*
- <u>Resolution</u> approving the City of Miami Gardens' codesignation of a portion of NW 156th Street between NW 42nd Avenue and NW 47th Avenue as "Omega Psi Phi Way." – *Passed*
- <u>Ordinance</u> amending the environmental regulations of the County Code to facilitate food service operations on agricultural properties that comply with requirements, without the need to obtain variances from the Environmental Quality Control Board after public hearing when such properties are served by an onsite domestic well system, an onsite sewage treatment and disposal system, or both. – *Passed*
- <u>Resolution</u> urging President Joe Biden and the Biden administration to take affirmative measures to ensure that internet access is restored in Cuba. *Passed*
- <u>Resolution</u> creating a Charter Review Task Force; setting forth membership, organization, powers and responsibilities of such task force.
  <u>Passed</u>
- <u>Resolution</u> directing County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to competitively select a consultant to prepare, at the sole cost of the NW 7th Avenue corridor community redevelopment agency, a finding of necessity study for expansion of NW 7th Avenue corridor community redevelopment area to include two geographical areas. – *Passed*
