## Some Highlights from the June 3 & 26, 2025 Commission Meeting



## Among the County Items:

- <u>Resolution</u> approving the implementation of the Mobility Sourcing Program for Department of Transportation and Public Works. The Mobility Sourcing Program is designed to address operational challenges and ensure reliability of transit systems. *Passed*
- Resolution directing the County Mayor to assess the solid waste outputs at properties used as vacation rentals. Passed
- <u>Resolution</u> directing the County Mayor to install adaptive fishing piers or floating docks at county parks so residents using wheelchairs or other mobility aids are able to enjoy fishing. *Passed*
- <u>Resolution</u> approving the change of the designation of August in the county from "Black Business Month" to "Black-Owned Business Month 305. – *Passed*
- Resolution approving a lease for the Liberty Square Phase Five development for affordable housing.- Passed
- <u>Resolution</u> authorizing the Public Health Trust to establish a multi-specialty health clinic for Trust employees outside of the county. Passed
- <u>Resolution</u> authorizing the donation of surplus firefighting equipment to the Cuerpo de Bomberos Villa Trina in Dominican Republic. –
  *Passed*
- <u>Resolution</u> approving the construction of a new animal shelter facility and relocation and renovation of an existing Animal Services Department trailer. – *Passed*
