

The following departments have had staff attend or providing exhibits at the County booth.

- Animal Services – Dog Facial Recognition Program

- Information Technology – Artificial Intelligence, Business Analytics, and new tech, as well as all coordination for County participation
- Internal Services – general participation in eGov
- Libraries – Speaker opportunity and display data dashboards for predictive analytics
- Management and Budget – general participation in eGov
- Office of the Mayor – Speaking engagements throughout event from various staff.
- Parks, Rec and Open Spaces – use of GIS and Asset Management, Virtual Reality

- Regulatory and Economic Resources – general participation in eGov, ePermitting
- Seaport – Speaking opportunity and general participation in eGov
- Solid Waste Management – Exploring sensor and camera data for predictive routing and collections.
- Transportation and Public Works – Speaking opportunities, SMART tech to improve mobility.
- Water and Sewer – general participation in eGov

Because Miami-Dade County provided a Founding Sponsorship, we were provided with the following:
