## **2017 STATE LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES**

- 1. **SADOWSKI AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAM** URGE the Florida Legislature to fully fund the Sadowski affordable housing programs.
- ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES SECURITY AND DISTANCE SUPPORT changes to the Florida Statute governing Assisted Living Facilities (ALFs) and Community Residential Homes to provide for greater security for residents and the community and to prohibit an ALF/Community Residential Home in a single-family or duplex residential neighborhood from accepting individuals diverted from the criminal justice system.
- 3. <u>NUISANCE ABATEMENT</u> SUPPORT amendments to Florida Statutes that would expand the definition of a public nuisance to include three (3) instances of felony possession of narcotics.
- 4. <u>FILM TAX CREDITS</u> SUPPORT legislation that would extend additional tax credits to the film industry in Florida.
- 5. MIAMI RIVER TUNNEL INLCUDE the project in FDOT's Capital Plan.
- 6. <u>NEW STARTS PROGRAM</u> SUPPORT amendments to Florida Statutes that increase State New Starts Funding from 12.5% to 25% for non-federal locally funded projects.
- 7. **EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT** SUPPORT funding for the City's emergency management needs.
- 8. <u>PUBLIC RECORDS SUITS/LEGISLATIVE REFORM</u> SUPPORT legislation that would amend/clarify Chapter 119 to prevent abuse of the public records statute.
- 9. **SHADE MEETINGS/EXECUTIVE SESSION** SUPPORT legislation that would amend FS § 286.11 regarding shade meetings for *anticipated* litigation. Currently, executive sessions are only held when there is *pending* litigation. The City supports amending the section to state that executive sessions can also be held when litigation is *anticipated*.
- 10. <u>VACATING AN ARBITRATION AWARD</u> AMEND F.S. § 682.13 to permit Circuit Court review from binding arbitrations involving terminations or cases involving relief of duty decisions.
- 11. WORKERS COMPENSATION CHAPTER 440 SUPPORT amendments to Florida Statute sections that unfairly burden the City of Miami.
- 12. <u>OFF-DUTY MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICERS</u> SUPPORT legislation that would create a program to contract for employment of off-duty municipal law enforcement officers for security services.
