Business owners who have their principal business within Miami-Dade County; and are active for no less than 10 years in the following profession, trade, or occupation (except for the nominee of the Miami-Dade County League of Cities, Inc.): <b>District 13 category: Architects</b> (All candidates are subject to verification of licensure.) Non-professional representatives of: The disabled community; the south Florida building trades Council; Miami-Dade League of Cities, Inc.; developers; Homeowner association representatives who are qualified by training or experience to pass on matters pertaining to construction and not be related directly or indirectly to the construction industry. With the exception of the representatives of the fire services and the elected official of a municipality nominated by the Miami-Dade County League of Cities, Inc., no member of the Board shall be an officer, agent or employee of the County or any municipality.
<b>Commission on Human Rights</b>	A Quasi-Judicial Board charged with the enforcement of the County's anti-discrimination ordinance; conducts public administrative hearings on appeals to determinations on cases of employment, housing, public accommodations, family leave etc. It may uphold, modify or overturn such determinations.	Residents and electors of Miami-Dade County, and who have outstanding reputations for civic Pride, integrity, responsibility, and interest in the area of equal opportunity.
