Section 1: Objective

Foster the growth and innovation of established businesses with a proven track record. Prioritize those that drive economic development, create jobs, and positively impact the community. Provide strong support to local micro and small businesses in Miami-Dade County that have been operational for at least three years.

Section 2: Criteria

A. Eligibility

- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.
- Businesses must have been in operation for a minimum of three (3) years, as verified by Sunbiz.org.
- The business must have a physical location in Miami-Dade County.
- Only one business with common ownership and/or management may be awarded.

B. Requirements

For-Profit-Business Requirements:

- 1. Provide the most recent three (3) years of tax return transcripts.
- 2. Demonstrate an average gross revenue between \$24,000 and \$750,000 over the past three (3) years.
- 3. Employ fewer than twenty-five (25) employees.
- 4. Ensure the business is not in default or non-compliance with any county loan or grant program.
- 5. Note that franchises or businesses affiliated with national chains are ineligible.
- 6. Align business operations with economic development goals such as community improvement, job creation, or sustainability.
- 7. Confirm that the business does not engage in any illegal activities.
- 8. Provide active Local Business Tax Receipt.
- 9. Provide IRS EIN Documentation.
- 10. Provide a valid Driver's License copy.

Non-For-Profit-Business Requirements:

- 1. Provide proof of **verified IRS active status**.
- 2. Demonstrate an average gross revenue between \$24,000 and \$750,000 over the past three (3) years.
- 3. Submit the most recent three (3) years of IRS Form 990.
- 4. Provide the most recent three (3) years of Balance Sheets, Income Statements, and/or Profit and Loss Statements.
- 5. Include Solicitation of Contributions from the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
- 6. Submit IRS tax-exempt status documentation.
- 7. Employ fewer than twenty-five (25) employees.
- 8. Ensure the business is not in default or non-compliance with any county loan or grant program.
- 9. Note that franchises or businesses affiliated with national chains are ineligible.
- 10. Align business operations with economic development goals such as community improvement, job creation, or sustainability.
- 11. Confirm that the business does not engage in any illegal activities.
- 12. Provide active Local Business Tax Receipt.
- 13. Provide IRS EIN Documentation.
- 14. Provide a valid Driver's License copy.

C. Submission Guidelines

- 2. <u>Executive Summary</u>: Submit a one-page summary detailing the business concept, market need, target audience, and impact.
- 3. <u>Pitch Deck:</u> Prepare a slide deck (5-10 slides) covering the problem, solution, market size, business model, competitive advantage, team, and financial projections.
- 4. <u>Video Submission:</u> Introduce yourself and your business idea in a compelling 2-3 minute video. Highlight the following: 1. Introduction 2. The Problem or Need 3. The Solution/Value Proposition 4. Target Market 5. Impact 6. Business Model and Revenue Plan 7. Funding Need and Use of Funds 8. Call to Action/Closing. All videos should be accessible *via an online link*. YouTube or Dropbox links are recommended.

- 1. Executive Summary (One-page max) Please provide a brief overview of your business idea, the problem it addresses, and your proposed solution.
- 2. Describe Your Target Audience Who are your primary customers, and why do they need your product/service?
- 3. Market Potential Provide a brief description of your market size and potential growth.
- 4. Business Model How do you plan to generate revenue (e.g., product sales, subscription model)?
- 5. Competitive Advantage What makes your business unique compared to competitors?
- 6. Current Progress and Milestones List any achievements, such as completed prototypes, sales, partnerships, or funding secured.
- 7. Funding Need and Use of Funds How would you use the grant funding if awarded?

E. Judging Criteria

- 1. <u>Innovation and Creativity:</u> Is the idea unique or a creative solution to an existing problem?
- 2. <u>Economic Impact:</u> Will the business create jobs, address economic needs, or benefit the community?
- 3. Scalability and Sustainability: Is the idea scalable, and can it be sustained long-term?
- 4. <u>Team and Execution Plan</u>: Does the applicant/team have the skills and plan to execute the idea?
- 5. <u>Presentation Quality</u>: Was the pitch well-prepared, clear, and engaging?

F. Competition Structure

- Initial Screening: Applications reviewed based on eligibility and business potential; top 7-10 applicants move to the semi-final round.
- Final Pitch Event: Finalists present live in front of judges and an audience. Each finalist gets 5-7 minutes for the pitch followed by a Q&A.

G. Prizes and Support

Monetary Awards: Substantial grants or seed funding for the top three winners, with prizes of \$15,000 for first place, \$10,000 for second place, and \$5,000 for third place, empowering them to scale their businesses.

Access to Resources and Networking Opportunities: Complimentary access to a wide range of local business resources, generously provided by our strategic partners, designed to support business growth and innovation.

Exclusive Marketing and Event Space: First-place winners receive premier marketing support and access to event spaces, courtesy of our esteemed community partners, to elevate their brand visibility and community engagement.

H. Terms and Conditions

Finalists will be required to agree to specific terms, as a recipient of Miami-Dade Economic Advocacy Trust grant funds.

Grant funds must be used for the business as outlined below:

- Inventory/Supplies/ (No Food Items)
- Business Equipment
- Marketing/Advertising
- Business Expansion
- Technology (e.g., computer, software, copier, etc.)
