



## NOVEMBER 5, 2024 MIAMI-DADE COUNTY GENERAL ELECTION RESOURCE ALLOCATIONS

For Early Voting locations, the Department's <u>preliminary</u> allocation is as follows (subject to change):

- 369 EVIDs: This allocation reflects 7 to 16 units at each voting location.
- 369 Ballot-on-Demand Printers: This allocation reflects 7 to 16 units at each voting location.
- 299 optical scanners: This allocation reflects 6 to 12 units at each voting location.
- 66 ExpressVote (ADA) voting units: This allocation reflects 2 units at each voting location.
- 2,510 Privacy Booths: This allocation reflects between 50 and 100 units at each voting location.
- 132 ADA Privacy Booths: This allocation reflects 4 units at each voting location.
- The Department will use approximately 1,000 site staff for Early Voting, which is between 25 and 35 employees per site, and will have 20 administrative and technical troubleshooters traversing the County for quick response time.

For Election Day voting locations, the Department's <u>preliminary</u> allocation is as follows (subject to change):

- 1,280 EVIDs: There will be a minimum of two units at each voting location. Additional units will be added based on the number of registered voters.
- 1,634 optical scanners: This allocation reflects 2 units at each voting location. Additional units will be added based on the number of registered voters.
- 523 ExpressVote (ADA) voting units: This allocation reflects 1 unit at each voting location.
- 7,200 privacy booths (includes ADA-accessible booths): This allocation reflects 8 to 10 units at each voting location.
- The Department anticipates using 5,200 poll workers for this election, which equates to 9 to 10 poll workers per polling location. We will up staff at locations as needed. In addition, we will have 85 administrative and technical troubleshooters, as well as 60 supply trucks traversing the County for quick response time.
