<b>Standard Staffing Per Site:</b>	30 staff members at each of the 30 Early Voting Sites = 900 total staff members (one shift): (1) Clerk, (2) Document Specialist, (5) Data Entry, (4) Ballot Distributor, (4) Privacy Booth Attendant, (4) DS200 Optical Scanner Attendant, (1) Deputy, (2) Breakers (1) Asst. Coordinator (1) Asst. Specialist (2) Voting Equipment Technician (3) Flow Coordinator An additional 12 staff members to support Early Voting Sites (one shift): (6) Administrative Rovers across County, (6) Voting Equipment Technician Rovers across County  Additional staffing may be assigned depending on the needs and capacity of a given site.

An additional 60 Technical Rovers to support Election Day voting locations countywide (one shift). 90 Administrative Troubleshooters (ATS) Rovers to support Election Day voting locations
