1. A maximum of two poll workers per polling location will be paid post-election pay for one of the following:
 - a. They are requested/designated to report to the Collection Center with essential election materials (typically Clerk/Asst. Clerk).
 - b. They are requested/designated to remain at the polling location until all election results are transmitted.
2. If a Standby is called and arrives at the precinct within one hour, they will be paid their regular pay, depending on position, plus \$40.00 for training. Standby poll workers will forfeit the training stipend and election day standby pay if they are called to work but are unable/unwilling due to one of the following:
 - a. unavailable
 - b. unreachable via phone
 - c. refuse a reasonably distanced (15 mins or less) precinct
 - d. any other reason not listed above

Note: To be paid the stipend, poll workers must participate in mandatory training, pre-election setup, and assigned Election Day duties.
