QUALIFICATIONS: [\[F.S. 103.091\(1\)\]](#) and [\[Miami-Dade County Republican Executive Committee Bylaws, Article I, Section 1\]](#)

1. Republican registered voter.
2. Resident of the district.

TYPE OF ELECTION: Partisan [\[F.S. 103.091\(1\)\]](#)

ELECTION AREA Districts [\[F.S. 103.091\(6\)\]](#)

DISTRICTS TO BE ELECTED: The Republican Executive Committee shall be composed of two registered Republican men and two registered Republican women elected from each County Committee district within Miami-Dade County, who shall be elected in accordance with the election laws of the State of Florida. There will be a total of 80 Committeemen and 80 Committeewomen as well as 1 State Committeeman and 1 State Committeewoman elected at-large countywide. [\[F.S. 103.091\(1\)\]](#) and [F.S. 103.091\(6\)](#) and [\[Miami-Dade County Republican Executive Committee Bylaws, Article I, Section 1\]](#)

TERM: Four (4) years, commencing on the 1st day of the month following the Presidential General Election [\[F.S. 103.091\(4\)\]](#)

SALARY: None

ELECTION DATE: August 30, 2016 – Primary [\[F.S. 103.091\(4\)\]](#)

QUALIFYING DATES: [\[F.S. 103.091\(4\)\]](#)
Noon, Monday, June 20, 2016, to Noon, Friday, June 24, 2016.

A qualifying office may accept and hold qualifying papers submitted not earlier than 14 days prior to the beginning of the qualifying period (June 6, 2016), to be processed and filed during the qualifying period [\[F.S. 99.061\(8\)\]](#).

QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS: [\[F.S. 99.021\(2\)\]](#)

During the qualifying period, the following **must** be submitted to the Miami-Dade Elections Department [\[F.S.99.021\(2\)\]](#) and [Miami-Dade County Republican Executive Committee Bylaws, Article I, Section 7](#):

1. Loyalty Oath Form ([REP Oath](#))
2. Candidate Oath
District Committeemen and Committeewomen ([Form DS-DE 24D](#))
State Committeemen and Committeewomen ([Form DS-DE 24E](#))
3. Receipt of Handbook and the Election Laws of the State of Florida ([Form MD-ED 2](#))

If you receive a contribution or make an expenditure, the following item must also be submitted to the Miami-Dade County Elections Department:

4. Campaign Treasurer's Report Electronic Filing Requirement for Miami-Dade County ([Form MD-ED 10](#))
