### Launch of Electronic Filing – Statement of Financial Interests (Form 1)

Recent changes to the financial disclosure laws provide that beginning January 1, 2023, the Statement of Financial Interests (Form 1) is available only by utilizing the Florida Commission on Ethics' electronic filing system.

Anyone wishing to file a Form 1 for qualifying purposes MUST register in the system to access the disclosure form. A valid email is required to register. Within the system, candidates will find helpful videos.

Candidates are required to submit a hard copy of the Form 1 to the filing officer at the time of qualifying.

Candidates are urged to allow ample time to register, create a profile, username/password, and complete the disclosure. Waiting until the last day of qualifying may not provide sufficient time to access the system, accurately complete the disclosure, print and file it with the qualifying officer.
