

**NOTICE OF QUALIFYING DATES
FOR THE OFFICE OF
Miami-Dade County School Board, District 1**

WHEREAS, section 100.111(1)(a), Florida Statutes, states that where the remainder of the term of an office required to be filled pursuant to § 1(f), Art. IV, Florida Constitution, is 28 months or longer, “then at the next general election a person shall be elected to fill the unexpired portion of such term;”

WHEREAS, the office of School Board is an office required to be filled pursuant to § 1(f), Art. IV, Florida Constitution;

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2026, Steve Gallon, III, resigned from the office of Miami-Dade County School Board, District 1, leaving more than 28 months left on the term;

WHEREAS, section 100.111(1)(c), Florida Statutes, provides that “[i]f such a vacancy occurs prior to primary election but on or after the first day set by law for qualifying, the Secretary of State shall set dates for qualifying for the unexpired portion of the term of such office;”

WHEREAS, the first day set by section 99.061(2), Florida Statutes, for qualifying for county office, including school board, is June 8, 2026;

THEREFORE, I, Cord Byrd, Secretary of State of the State of Florida, do hereby fix and declare that the date on which candidates may qualify for the unexpired portion of the term for Miami-Dade County School Board, District 1, shall be from Noon, June 10, 2026, through Noon, June 16, 2026 (excluding weekend).
