NOVEMBER 3, 2020 MIAMI-DADE COUNTY GENERAL ELECTION RESOURCE ALLOCATIONS

For Early Voting locations, the Department's preliminary allocation is as follows (subject to change):

- 330 EVIDs: This allocation reflects 6 to 14 units at each voting location, with 1 serving as back up.
- 330 Ballot-on-Demand Printers: This allocation reflects 6 to 14 units at each voting location.
- 330 DS200 optical scanners: This allocation reflects 6 to 14 units at each voting location, with 1 serving as back up.
- 66 ExpressVote (ADA) voting units: This allocation reflects 2 units at each voting location, with 1 serving as back up at each site.
- 3,168 Privacy Booths: This allocation reflects between 50 and 120 units at each voting location.
- 132 ADA Privacy Booths: This allocation reflects 4 units at each voting location.
- The Department will use approximately 1,020 site staff for Early Voting, which equates to between 25 and 35 employees per site, and will have 20 administrative and technical troubleshooters traversing the County for quick response time.

For Election Day voting locations, the Department's allocation is as follows (subject to change):

- 1,280 EVIDs: depending on the number of registered voters, there will be a minimum of two and a maximum of three units at voting locations with 3,500 or more voters.
- 1,639 DS200 optical scanners: This allocation reflects 2 units at each voting location.
- 567 ExpressVote (ADA) voting units: This allocation reflects 1 units at each voting location.
- 7,208 privacy booths (includes ADA):1 : This allocation reflects 8 to 10 units at each voting location.
- The Department anticipates using 5,100 poll workers for this election, which equates to 8 to 10 poll workers per polling location, and will have 90 administrative and technical troubleshooters, as well as 60 supply trucks traversing the County for quick response time.
