NOVEMBER 8, 2022 MIAMI-DADE COUNTY GENERAL ELECTION RESOURCE ALLOCATIONS

For Early Voting locations, the Department's <u>preliminary</u> allocation is as follows (subject to change):

- 175 EVIDs: This allocation reflects 5 to 8 units, depending on the location, with 1 serving as back up.
- 105 Ballot-on-Demand Printers: This allocation reflects 3 to 5 units, depending on the location.
- 162 DS200 optical scanners: This allocation reflects 4 to 8 units depending on the location, with 1 serving as back up.
- 56 ExpressVote (ADA) voting units: This allocation reflects 1 unit at each location, with 1 serving as back up at each site.
- 1,585 Privacy Booths: This allocation reflects between 50 and 80 units at each location.
- 84 ADA Privacy Booths: This allocation reflects 3 units at each location.
- The Department will use approximately 900 site staff for Early Voting, which is between 27 and 32 employees per site and will have 20 administrative and technical troubleshooters traversing the County for quick response time.

For Election Day voting locations, the Department's <u>preliminary</u> allocation is as follows (subject to change):

- 1,179 EVIDs: depending on the number of registered voters, there will be a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 3 units at voting locations.
- 1,107 DS200 optical scanners: This allocation reflects 2 units at each voting location. Additional equipment may be added based on unique circumstances.
- 548 ExpressVote (ADA) voting units: This allocation reflects 1 unit at each voting location.
- 6,144 privacy booths (includes ADA accessible booths): This allocation reflects a minimum of 5 units at each voting location. Additional equipment will be added to larger locations.
- The Department anticipates using 5,000 poll workers for this election, which equates to 9 poll
 workers per polling location and will have 90 administrative and technical troubleshooters, as
 well as 60 supply trucks traversing the County for quick response time.
