Following an unprecedented fish kill, BBTF Chair provides special presentation to County Mayor and Commission.


Biscayne Bay is in Decline

We Now Know That What Happens On The Land Ends Up In Our Bay!








- Advise County Mayor & Board of County Commissioners

 - Septic to Sewer Conversions
 - Wastewater Improvements
 - Stormwater Improvements
 - Restoration of Coastal Habitats
- Improve public education and advocate the importance of restoring Biscayne Bay and report on progress.

Biscayne Bay Task Force Recommendations Allowed Us To:
