



Miami-Dade County GSA SCHEDULE OF FINES

Applicable to all owners, Public and Private

In accordance with the Florida Statutes Chapter 399, Florida Administrative Code 61C-5 and Chapter 30 of the Florida Building Code, the Office of Elevator Safety may impose fines of up to \$1,000 for certain violations of the Statute and of various codes. The following fine schedule will be followed as a guideline, and the Office of Elevator Safety reserves the right to impose such fines after the determination of a violation, by issuance of a civil summons or by administrative action.

- * For the purposes of this schedule of fines, "the code" is as defined in Chapter 399 of the Florida Statutes, the Florida Building Code, and in the Florida Administrative Code 61C-5, all of which adopt the American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) A17.1 - 2000, the National Electric Code, ASME A17.2- 2000, and the ASME A17.3- 2000, and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
- The imposition of a progressive schedule of fines for repetitive offenses is rolled back after one year following the last violation, if there are no additional violations.
- All fines must have a ten dollar (\$10.00) surcharge added pursuant to County Ordinance No. 99-55.
- Additional repeat violations may be imposed if no action is taken after twenty (20) working days.
- Appeals to these fines may be subject to additional fees and court costs, as determined by the hearing officer.
- Fines are due and payable in U.S. Funds, by check only made payable to the Miami-Dade County Clerk of Court, within twenty (20) working days following the imposition of the fine by issuance of a ticket or by administrative order of the Miami-Dade County Office of Elevator Safety.
