## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the transfer of Passenger Motor Carrier (PMC) Certificate of Transportation No. 30317 from Jamal Kamal Hidmi d/b/a Miami's Best Tours & Transportation, Inc. to Gary Shteyn d/b/a ALS Air, Land and Sea Luxury Transportation & Services, Inc.

## **Scope**

This PMC Certificate of Transportation is countywide, allowing the certificate holder to operate in unincorporated and incorporated areas of Miami-Dade County.

## **Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

Licensing, operating permit and inspection fees are collected by the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources to support regulatory activities. There is an annual regulatory fee of \$625.00 per certificate and \$625.00 per vehicle that will yield \$1,250.00 in revenue annually for the first vehicle and \$625.00 for each additional vehicle. PMC certificate holders can operate an unlimited number of vehicles under the certificate. The County also collects \$38.00 per vehicle inspection with frequency varying with the vehicle age from one (1) to four (4) inspections per year.

## **Track Record/Monitor**

The applicant is a new permit holder and is in compliance with all requirements of the Code of Miami-Dade County (Code). Joe Mora, Division Chief within the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources, will be responsible for monitoring this company.

## **Background**

On February 17, 1981, the Board adopted Ordinance 81-17, subsequently amended by Ordinance 85-20 on April 16, 1985, which regulates the passenger motor carrier industry in Miami-Dade County under Chapter 31 of the Code.

Section 31-103 (m) of the Code provides the procedures to be followed by Miami-Dade County in processing transfer applications. No certificate may be sold, assigned or transferred to another until the proposed sale, assignment, or transfer has been approved by the Board. In considering the proposed transfer of ownership or control of the certificate, the Board shall determine whether or not said transfer is contrary to the public interest, upon evidence submitted at the public hearing. The Board may

approve or refuse to approve said transfer upon such terms and conditions or may reasonably alter, restrict or modify the terms and provisions of such transfer if in the public's interest.

Jamal Kamal Hidmi d/b/a Miami's Best Tours & Transportation, Inc. has filed an application to transfer Passenger Motor Carrier Certificate of Transportation No. 30317 to Gary Shteyn d/b/a ALS Air, Land and Sea Luxury Transportation & Services, Inc. Issued on July 13, 1999, via Resolution R-753-99 (Attachment A), PMC No. 30317 authorizes special operations service. This class of service is defined as transportation of persons in a motor vehicle to a common destination or series of common destinations where the person may be charged as an individual or as part of a group, including but not limited to charter, sightseeing, or subscription service, not between fixed terminals or on a regular route.

The company is required to adhere to the terms of Resolution R-753-99, which approved the certificate. Gary Shteyn d/b/a ALS Air, Land and Sea Luxury Transportation & Services, Inc., located at 1455 N. Treasure Drive, #2R, North Bay Village, Florida 33141, seeks to continue providing this class of service by transporting tourist and resident groups to and from various locations throughout Miami-Dade County 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Transportation is required to be pre-arranged at least 24 hours prior to service, using chauffeur-driven vehicles with a seating capacity of nine or more, but less than 28 passengers, excluding the driver. The proposed rates are listed on the attached rate schedule (Attachment B).

The management plan submitted by Mr. Gary Shteyn, President of ALS Air, Land and Sea Luxury Transportation & Services, Inc., includes maintenance, communication, and recordkeeping systems and meets the requirements of the Code. All required financial statements and credit references have been submitted and the proposed service standards adequately meet passenger transportation and comfort needs. A background investigation reveals no criminal conviction for the applicant or any corporate officers within five years of the date of the application.

As required by the Code, the applicant has provided disclosure of the terms and conditions regarding the transfer of the certificate. The application for transfer of PMC Certificate of Transportation was originally submitted in August 2007 and included a notarized Bill of Sale for \$30,000.00. Subsequently, the two parties engaged in a legal dispute regarding the transfer of the PMC Certificate. Due to the nature of the transaction and the various issues raised by the parties, this matter was determined in a court of law. On February 23, 2015, the Circuit Court of the 11<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit issued a Declaratory Judgment that Gary Shteyn was entitled to PMC Certificate of Transportation No. 30317 and that Jamal Kamal Hidmi had no further rights to this certificate (Case No. 11-14012-CA-02, Attachment C). However, pursuant to Section 31-103 (m) of the Code, the Board of County Commissioners must determine if such transfer complies with the certification process and is in the public interest and, if so, the Board may approve or modify the terms of such transfer.



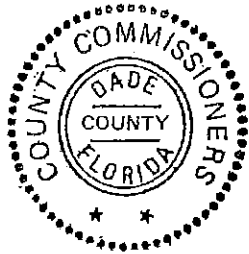
WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

**RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board approve the application of Jamal Kamal Hidmi d/b/a Miami's Best Tours & Transportation, Inc. for a Passenger Motor Carrier Certificate of Transportation to provide pre-arranged special operations service.

**BACKGROUND**

On February 17, 1981, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 81-17, subsequently amended by Ordinance 85-20 on April 16, 1985, which regulates the passenger motor carrier industry in Miami-Dade County under Chapter 31 of the Code of Miami-Dade County.

Section 31-103 of the Code provides the procedures to be followed by Miami-Dade County in processing certificate applications. Based on those requirements, a public hearing has been scheduled before the Board of County Commissioners. At the conclusion of the public hearing the Board may issue or refuse to issue the certificate, or issue the certificate with such modifications or upon such terms and conditions as in its judgment the public interest may require. In reaching its determination, the Board shall consider the application, the County Manager's report and recommendation, all matters presented at the public hearing, and among others, the following criteria:

- (1) That the applicant is fit, willing and able in accordance with the requirements of this section, to provide the transportation to be authorized by this certificate and is able to comply with this article and regulations of the commission.
- (2) That the transportation to be provided under the requested certificate is consistent with the public interest.
- (3) That the proposed transportation service will improve the quality of transportation available to the public.



ANALYSIS

Jamal Kamal Hidmi d/b/a Miami's Best Tours & Transportation, Inc., located at 2699 Collins Avenue, Suite 112, Miami Beach, Florida 33143, seeks to obtain a Passenger Motor Carrier Certificate of Transportation to provide pre-arranged special operations service transportation to passengers throughout all of Miami-Dade County. This class of service is defined as the transportation of persons to a common destination or series of common destinations where the person may be charged as an individual or as part of a group, including but not limited to charter, sightseeing, or subscription service, not between fixed terminals or on a regular route.

The company is a tour operator that seeks to transport tourists to and from various locations throughout Miami-Dade County. Transportation will be pre-arranged on a 24-hour minimum basis. These services will be provided seven days a week, 24 hours a day, using chauffeur-driven vehicles with a seating capacity of nine or more, but less than 28 passengers, excluding the driver. The proposed rates are listed on the attached rate schedule.

The management plan submitted by Mr. Jamal Kamal Hidmi, President of Miami's Best Tours & Transportation, Inc., includes maintenance, communication, and record keeping systems and meets the requirements of the Code. All required financial statements and credit references have been submitted and the proposed service standards adequately meet passenger transportation and comfort needs. A background investigation reveals no criminal conviction for the applicant or any corporate officers within five years of the date of the application.

In accordance with Section 31-103(e) of the Code, a 20-day notice of application was provided to all affected municipalities within Miami-Dade County, all passenger motor carrier certificate holders and interested parties. No protests were filed.

This application was filed prior to the adoption of R-1404-98 which provides that new applications will not be received by the department after December 15, 1998; however, applications on file will be processed for Board consideration.

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## AGREED ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF GARY SHTEYN'S MOTION FOR DECLARATORY JUDGMENT


